- NOTE 3 Where storage-in-transit shipment is not unloaded at carrier's warehouse, and shipment remains on carrier's vehicle, an overnight S.I.T. flat charge of \$150.00 per vehicle will be assessed. A flat charge based on two hours at the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2 or 3 when distance from original point of origin to final destination is more than 20 miles but not to exceed 40 miles.
