

I write to you in request to deny the motion of dismissal filed to you by the Philadelphia Gas Works (PGW), on the grounds of the material sent in the motion not complying with any material sent prior to the filing of my complaint.

To begin, the PGW would have one believe that a series of complaints filed against them is frivolous and unjust, whereas the company did not acknowledge the series of notice sent to me for shut off, even though payments were made promptly, some times in excess of the bills received. The constant toil of a notice producing, a phone call made and a complete uphill battle launched regarding an agreement had left me with no alternative to contact the PUC for resolution.

The amounts that were requested varied, for instance, an agreement for the amount of \$1,000 could change to \$6,000 in a heartbeat. Even in the motion filed, an amount of \$3,976.53 was requested to be paid in full, and yet it is not described as to where this amount came from, how it produced, and what it will satisfy.

The reason behind my complaint is the constant shifting of payment amounts between the CRP as well as the principle balance, and this motion continues the trend of imaginative payment amounts to be given from me to the company without explanation. I have asked in the past 7 months for a breakdown of my account to see how all of this is calculated, however no material has been sent to me upon request. Ironically, the notion states to ask for any pertinent information. Since it has come to a point that neither side is able to come to a logical, sensible agreement, I would like to have my hearing and explain my position in front of you as I intended to, and request that the motion be held until that day.
