



LEGAL NAME AND DOMICILE OF APPLICANT

Comes now, Canterbury International Incorporated d/b/a Two Men And A Truck, hereinafter called Applicant, in the above entitled proceeding, a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, with address at 3555 Valley Drive, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15234 and submits this, its verified statement in support of the above captioned application.

II  
IDENTITY AND QUALIFICATIONS OF TESTIFYING WITNESS

My name is Raymond J Coll. I am the president, and a director and stockholder of Applicant. I am familiar with the daily activities of Applicant, all the operations of Applicant, its personnel, solicitation, facilities, equipment, and finances. I am authorized to give this statement.

III  
AFFILIATION

Applicant is not affiliated in any way with any other intrastate carrier, nor is any person affiliated with Applicant affiliated with any other intrastate carrier.

IV  
AUTHORITY SOUGHT AND STATEMENT OF FACTS

By the instant applicant, Applicant seeks authority for the transportation of household goods in use, in the territory as shown on Exhibit No. 1 attached hereto and made a part hereof. This application was acknowledged as filed on or about December 28, 2006, and had been published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of January 13, 2007, Vol. 33, No. 13, at page 292. Protests were filed to this application by South Hill Movers, Inc.; Weleski Transfer, Inc.; Central Van & Storage of Charleston, Inc. d/b/a Central Van & Storage Company, Inc.; Vesly Bros. Moving & Storage, Inc.; and Century III Moving Systems, Inc. t/d/b/a Clairton Transfer Company and Pleasant Hills Van & Storage. By Hearing Notice dated March 12, 2007, this application proceeding was scheduled for an Initial Hearing on May 2, 2007 before the Hon. Fred R. Nene, ALJ in Pittsburgh, PA. Thereafter, upon request of Applicant's counsel with the consent of Protestants' counsel, the Initial Hearing was rescheduled to June 19, 2007 in Pittsburgh, PA before the Hon. Fred R. Nene, ALJ. Prior to the start of the Initial Hearing on June 19, 2007, Applicant and Protestants amicably resolved their differences, stated such on the record upon the commencement of the June 19, 2007 Initial Hearing, and Protestants withdrew their respective protests on the record. Upon the request of Applicant, the Hon. Fred R. Nene, ALJ ordered on the record that the subject application be referred to the Commission's Transportation and Safety Bureau for further consideration and disposition as an unopposed application through the submission of written verified statements. By letter dated July 5, 2007 from Tim Zeigler, Compliance Office - Technical Unit, Motor Carrier Services and Enforcement

Bureau of Transportation and Safety, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, this application was assigned for review without oral hearing and Applicant was directed to file verified statements of itself and supporting parties in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Section 3.381(e)(1) by August 6, 2007.

V

GENERAL SCOPE OF PRESENTLY AUTHORIZED OPERATIONS

Applicant presently is an authorized and licensed motor carrier in interstate and intrastate commerce holding operating authority as shown on Exhibit No. 2 attached hereto and made a part hereof. Presently, Applicant is authorized to and does transport household goods in use in interstate commerce between points in the United States; household goods in use in intrastate Pennsylvania commerce between points in Allegheny County; and commercial property in intrastate commerce between points in Pennsylvania.

VI

DUPLICATING AUTHORITY

The authority sought in the instant application is to transport household goods in use from points in Allegheny County, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa. Accordingly, the authority sought in the instant applicaiton does not duplicate, in whole or in part, any authority presently held by Applicant from this Commission. Therefore, no duplicating authority is involved herein.

VII

DUAL OPERATIONS

Applicant holds no contract carrier authority from this Commission. Dual operations are not involved.

VIII

PERTINENT TERMINAL FACILITIES AND COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK

Applicant has its main office and principal place of business at 3555 Valley Drive, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15234. At this location, Applicant has eight hundred (800) square feet

of warehouse facilities, and two thousand two hundred (2,200) square feet for offices, operations, and dispatching facilities. Also at its present location, Applicant has sufficient space for parking twenty (20) employee vehicles and fifteen (15) 26' moving van straight trucks. Applicant's operations at this location is permitted by local zoning laws and is conducted five (5) days a week. Applicant's offices contain adequate office furnishings, equipment, computers, six (6) telephone lines to receive and respond to customer/public requests for service, and a GPS tracking system. Moreover, all of Applicant's trucks have cellular telephones in the vehicle(s) for dispatch and to permit communications between the vehicle(s) and the office/central dispatch. The GPS tracking system and use of cellular telephones in the trucks not only allows Applicant to track the vehicles utilized in its operations, but also provides for instant dispatch communications between the office and the vehicle's driver, and provide that the public be immediately advised upon call to Applicant of shipment transportation status. These foregoing facilities are also described on Exhibit No. 3 attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Presently, Applicant employs the services of an operation's manager, an estimator, movers, drivers, and administration and customer service personnel as shown and described on Exhibit No. 4 attached hereto and made a part hereof. This personnel will also be utilized in the operations proposed in the instant application.

## IX

### PERTINENT EQUIPMENT

At the present time, Applicant owns and operates the equipment listed on Exhibit No. 5 attached hereto and made a part hereof. This equipment is utilized in Applicant's present operations and will be utilized in the operations proposed herein and the territory sought herein upon the issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity by this Commission. Applicant anticipates securing more vehicles and operational equipment, through purchase and/or lease arrangements, as business develops and expands, and will rent or lease vehicle(s) for



emergency situations such as mechanical breakdowns or maintenance. These vehicles will be regularly inspected, cleaned and maintained in accordance with the equipment and safety regulations of this Commission.

Applicant also has the the household goods moving equipment and supplies shown on Exhibit No. 6, attached hereto and made a part hereof, that are utilized in its present operations and are available for use in the operations proposed in the instant application.

X

SAFETY PROGRAM

Applicant is aware of the safety rules and regulations, as outlined by this Commission and the Commonwealth. A complete safety program has been established to insure compliance with the requirements of this Commission, as well as maintenance of proper records reflecting vehicle condition, drivers' hours of service and qualifications, accident reports, and medical certificates. I will designate employees or perform this service myself, or retain outside contractors to supervise the safety program for my company. To my knowledge, there are no investigations or proceedings for penalty or civil forfeiture, filed or pending against Applicant by any state or federal regulatory body in which the operating practices or fitness of Applicant is at issue. Attached hereto as Exhibit No. 7 is the most recent letter from this Commission showing that Applicant's has a "Satisfactory" safety rating from this Commission

XI

SERVICE NOW OFFERED TO SUPPORTING WITNESSES

Applicant presently conducts for-hire operations for the public in interstate or intrastate commerce, as authorized, transporting household goods in use between points in Allegheny County, or between points in the United States in interstate commerce, in safe and clean vehicles, and in a timely, efficient, and economical manner for/to the public. Also, Applicant presently conducts operations for the public, as authorized, transporting commercial property between points in Pennsylvania.

XII

TYPE OF SERVICE OFFERED

Applicant proposes to offer a service of transporting household goods in use, in the territory sought as shown on Exhibit No. 1 attached hereto and made a part hereof, in safe and clean vehicles, and in a timely, efficient, and economical manner for/to the public

XIII

FINANCIAL DATA

Attached hereto as Exhibit No. 8, and made a part hereof, is a true and correct copy of Applicant's latest balance sheet and profits and loss statement for the calendar year 2006 and for the period January, 2007 through May, 2007. In view of the foregoing and attached, it can be seen that Applicant is in sound financial condition to perform the proposed operation.

XIV

OTHER INFORMATION DEEMED PERTINENT

Applicant already is a certificated/licensed interstate and intrastate motor carrier familiar with conducting operations of transporting household goods in use for the public between points in Allegheny County, PA and between points in the United States, as authorized. Applicant is therefore familiar with the operational and financial requirements of transporting household goods in use for the public in intrastate and interstate commerce (as authorized) in a safe, lawful, timely, efficient, and economical manner for the public. Accordingly, Applicant believes it is familiar with and can conduct the household goods in use transportation proposed in the instant application in a successful, safe, and lawful manner responsive to a public need..

Applicant has already discussed with these persons and made them aware Applicant, if the authority sought is granted by this Commission, will not make pick-ups or deliveries of household goods in use beyond the scope of any authority grant.

Furthermore, attached hereto as Exhibit No. 9, and made a part hereof, is a true and correct copy of requests for household goods in use services beyond Applicant's existing authority, which Applicant has received at its offices directly (without referral) from the public. Although it could not and did not perform any of the services requested in Exhibit No. 9, Applicant believes this exhibit demonstrates existence of a public need for authority sought herein.

Therefore, Applicant believes there is an existing public need for the authority sought throughout the territory sought in the instant application, and respectfully requests the opportunity to submit supplemental or additional information, documentation, or public witnesses's verified statements if this Commission deems such is required.

Applicant believes in the free enterprise and market place system of fair, lawful, and open competition among members of the business community, ie. the more competition the better the public is served. Therefore, Applicant believes no existing carriers will be harmed by a grant of this application since no existing carrier handling the household goods in use transportation needs of the public in an adequate, safe, timely, and satisfactory manner, as promised by Applicant, need worry about diversion of business. Therefore, based on the foregoing, I respectfully request this application be granted to Applicant.



**ORDER**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

This matter comes before the Commission on an application filed December 29, 2004. Public notice of the application was given in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* of March 12, 2005 with protests due by April 4, 2005. The unopposed application is certified to the Commission for its decision without oral hearing.

**DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS**

Canterbury International, Incorporated (applicant or Canterbury) seeks to commence providing household goods in use service by acquiring through transfer the household goods in use right held by John Finnegan, t/d/b/a A-1 Moving. Operations will be conducted from facilities located at 5415 Clairton Boulevard, Pittsburgh, Allegheny County. Office and truck storage will be at this location. Communication will be by land phone and cellular phones. Applicant will initially lease two 27 foot straight trucks. The vehicles will be regularly



inspected, cleaned and maintained. Canterbury plans to hire four to six employees. Two of the employees will be drivers. Applicant will check the driving records and run a criminal record check on the drivers. Employees will be subject to random drug testing. A comprehensive maintenance and safety program will be implemented.

Raymond J. Coll, the sole shareholder of Canterbury, is prepared to contribute additional funds as maybe necessary for startup costs.

Raymond J. Coll, president and sole stockholder of applicant, has over 40 years of business management experience. He has held executive positions with several of Pittsburgh's largest construction companies. Coll has skills in negotiating, staff motivation, arbitrations, estimating, cost management, program development and labor relations.

Dorothy Coll will assist Raymond Coll in the day-to-day operations of applicant. Dorothy has experience in education and community business development that will be an asset to applicant.

The total consideration for the right \$28,700.

The authority to be transferred has been operated by the transferor; therefore, it is presumed that there is a continuing need, which may be overcome only by evidence to the contrary. In re: Byerly, 270 A.2d 186 (Pa. 1970); Hostetter v. Pa. P.U.C., 49 A.2d 862 (Pa. Super 1947).
