Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Pursuant to Section 5.94(a) of the Commission's regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a), the Bureau of Investigation & Enforcement (I&E) hereby withdraws the Complaint in the above-referenced case.

On May 4, 2016, I&E filed a Complaint alleging that Robert Z. Getz (Respondent), failed to pay the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's (Commission) assessment for the July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016 Fiscal Year and file an assessment report stating revenues earned during the 2014 calendar year. I&E sought payment of the assessment in the amount of \$255 as well as a civil penalty of \$1,293 for the violations alleged in the Complaint.

Subsequent to the filing of the Complaint, I&E became aware that Respondent passed away on April 25, 2016. I&E also understands that steps are being taken to cancel Respondent's Commission-issued operating authority. Given these circumstances, I&E withdraws the instant Complaint.

Copies of this letter have been served on the parties of record. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a), a party may object to this letter petition within ten (10) days of service. **Should Respondent agree with the withdrawal of I&E's Complaint, no action is required.**
