

NOTE 1 - MINIMUM TRANSPORTATION CHARGES: Sundays and Holidays: 8 hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 2. Saturdays (Any Hour) and Weekdays: 5:01 PM to 7:00 AM: 4 hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 4.

NOTE 2 - Rates in Column 4 apply only from 5:01 PM to 12:00 Midnight on any day when a higher rate is shown.

NOTE 3 - When a piano, riding mower, and big screen t.v. (50" and over) is part of a move, the following charge in dollars will be assessed for each piano, riding mower and big screen t.v. (50" and over") in addition to hourly rates shown above.

- (1) Other than players and grands,
riding mower; big screen t.v. (50" and over).....\$50.00
- (2) Players and grands.....\$100.00

NOTE AA - A flat charge based on one hour at the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, or 4 will be assessed when the distance from original point of origin to final destination is 10 miles or less.

A flat charge based on one and one-half hours at the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 will be assessed when the distance from original point of origin to final destination is more than 10 miles but not exceeding 20 miles.

A flat charge based on two hours at the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 will be assessed when the distance from original point of origin to final destination is more than 20 miles (to 40 miles inclusive).
