#### **DECISION**

#### I. INTRODUCTION

#### A. SUMMARY

In this Decision, the Department of Public Utility Control grants Stanwich Energy Advisors, LLC an Electric Aggregator Certificate of Registration to serve commercial, industrial, municipal and governmental customers in Connecticut.

#### B. BACKGROUND OF THE PROCEEDING

By application filed September 9, 2008 (Application) pursuant to § 16-245(I) of the General Statutes of Connecticut (Conn. Gen. Stat.), Stanwich Energy Advisors, LLC (Stanwich or Company) applied to the Department of Public Utility Control (Department) for a registration to operate as an electric aggregator within Connecticut.

#### C. CONDUCT OF THE PROCEEDING

No person requested a hearing. The Department determined that a hearing was not necessary in this matter; and thus, none was held. Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-245(I) (4).

#### D. PARTICIPANTS TO THE PROCEEDING

The Department recognized Stanwich Energy Advisors, LLC, 777 West Putnam Avenue, Greenwich, CT 06830; and the Office of Consumer Counsel (OCC), Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut 06051, as participants to this proceeding.

#### II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

Stanwich proposes to serve commercial, industrial, municipal and governmental customers throughout Connecticut. The Company's headquarters is 777 West Putnam Avenue, Greenwich, CT 06830. The Company's main telephone number is 914-689-5056. Stanwich is a limited liability company formed on August 5, 2008 in the state of Connecticut. Application, A-6. Its contact person for regulatory matters is John O'Connell. Application, A-3.

Pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-245(I)(e)(3), the Company disclosed that Stanwich is not currently under investigation or has ever been fined, sanctioned or otherwise penalized in any state for violation of any consumer protection law or regulation. Further, Stanwich also affirmed that it will comply with the National Labor Relations Act and the Connecticut Unfair Trade Practices Act and applicable regulations.

#### III. CONCLUSION AND ORDERS

#### A. CONCLUSION

After reviewing the Application, the Department grants Stanwich a Certificate of Registration to provide electric aggregation services to commercial, industrial, municipal and governmental customers in the state. Stanwich is reminded that it is under a continuing obligation to notify the Department of any changes to the information provided in the Application.

#### B. ORDERS

- 1. Stanwich shall maintain its customer complaint records to indicate: (1) the date of the complaint; (2) the name and address of the complainant; (3) the address or location of the complaint; (4) a description of the complaint; and (5) a description of the resolution of the complaint.
- 2. No later than November 15, 2008, Stanwich shall provide the Department a sample copy of the notice to be issued to aggregated customers as required pursuant to §16-245-3(d) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

#### **OPERATING AGREEMENT**

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#### OF

#### STANWICH ENERGY ADVISORS LLC

AGREEMENT made as of the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2008, by and between STEPHEN M. BANKER ("Banker"), an individual having an address at 777 West Putnam Ave., Greenwich, CT 06830 and JOHN C. O'CONNELL ("O'Connell"), an individual with an address at 777 West Putnam Ave., Greenwich, CT 06830 (each of the foregoing is hereinafter referred to individually as a "Member" or collectively as the "Members".)

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Members desire to form, pursuant to the Law (as hereinafter defined), a Connecticut limited liability company styled Stanwich Energy Advisors LLC (hereinafter, the "Company"), and desire to enter into this Agreement to set forth the terms and conditions pursuant to which the Company shall conduct its business.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties agree to the following intending to be legally bound:

#### ARTICLE 1 MEMBERS, TERM, NAME, PURPOSE AND PLACE OF BUSINESS

1.1 <u>Formation of the Company</u>. The parties hereby agree to form a limited liability company, styled Stanwich Energy Advisors LLC under the Connecticut Limited Liability Company Law, as such Law may from time to time be amended (the "Law"). In furtherance of the foregoing, the Members caused Articles of Organization for the Company to be filed with the Connecticut Secretary of State's office on or about August 5, 2008.

1.2 <u>Name</u>. The name of the Company is Stanwich Energy Advisors LLC. The business of the Company shall be conducted solely under such name and title to all assets of the Company shall be held in such name.

1.3 <u>Purposes of the Company.</u>

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(a) To provide energy consulting services to businesses and property owners. The Company's rights to any property rights, including, but not limited to, bank accounts and intellectual property rights hereinafter called the "Property".

(b) To sell, exchange or otherwise transfer or dispose of the Property, or any part thereof or interest therein pursuant to and in accordance with this Agreement; and

(c) To engage in such other activities as may be permitted by law in connection with the acquisition, ownership, operation or disposition of the Property pursuant to and in accordance with this Agreement.

1.4 <u>Company Filings</u>. The Members shall execute and file all documents required by the Law to be filed in connection with the continuation of the Company and to preserve and maintain the limited liability of its Members.

1.5 <u>Place of Business</u>. The principal place of business of the Company shall be 777 West Putnam Ave., Greenwich, Connecticut 06830 or at such other location within the state of Connecticut as may be selected by the Managers (hereinafter defined) from time to time.

1.6 <u>Term</u>. The Company shall continue until dissolved and liquidated pursuant to the provisions of Article 7 hereof.






