Dear Respondent:

On August 19, 1999, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety instituted a complaint against Stephen M. Andrulonis, t/a Andrulonis Trucking, respondent, alleging failure to maintain proper evidence of current insurance in violation of the Public Utility Code. The respondent was duly notified that if acceptable evidence of insurance or an answer was not filed, the Bureau would request that the Secretary of the Commission revoke the certificate of public convenience issued to the respondent at A-00115762.

The complaint and notice were served on the respondent on August 23, 1999. In response to the complaint, the respondent requested a voluntary suspension on September 2, 1999. The respondent's request was granted by Secretarial letter dated September 2, 1999. The respondent was directed to advise the Commission in writing that operations were being resumed and have acceptable evidence of insurance filed with the Commission on or before June 25, 2000. The respondent has failed to provide notification that the respondent intends to resume service, nor has acceptable evidence of insurance been filed. Therefore, the allegation in the complaint is deemed to be admitted.

The complaint at A-00115762C9901 is hereby sustained and the right(s) and the certificate of public convenience issued to the respondent at A-00115762 be and are hereby revoked; and the respondent has no other operating authority. The respondent is hereby notified to cease and desist from providing service previously authorized under the certificate of public convenience.
