MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE COMPLAINTS

West Penn Power Company (“West Penn”) requests that the above-captioned Complaints of Thomas Williams (“Complainant”) be consolidated, and in support thereof West Penn submits as follows:

1. On or about March 3, 2016, the Complainant filed a Complaint against West Penn at Docket No. C-2016-2532795. The Complainant alleged that West Penn incorrectly billed the Complainant for electric service at 417 McClellandtown Road, Uniontown, Pennsylvania (“Service Address”). The Complainant contends that the Complainant is not consuming electric service at the service address in the amount billed by West Penn. West Penn filed an Answer on March 28, 2016, in opposition to the Complaint.

2. By hearing notice dated June 10, 2016, a telephonic hearing on the Complaint at Docket No C-2016-2532795 was scheduled for Thursday, July 14, 2016, at 10 a.m. before Administrative Law Judge Mark A. Hoyer.

4. Pursuant to Section 5.81 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, 52 Pa. Code §5.81, West Penn submits that the Complaints be consolidated as they involve identical issues of law and fact.


