Dear Secretary:

In an effort to resolve this matter amicably between both parties, I respectfully request that you grant me a new hearing. Due to extenuating circumstances related to work, I was not able to attend the previously scheduled hearing on February 29, 2016 at 9:00am.

Please note that I attempted to have the hearing continued but could not as PECO's attorney objected and said " I was abusing the system by asking for the continuous". She then stated "I had filed four previous complaints and had an active complaint now".

While I have filed prior complaints, it was not in an attempt to abuse the system but to get a resolution to my situation. This is the case today. The commission has agreed to give me a payment arrangement but I would not be able to afford it. My current electric bill runs about \$150 a month and PECO wants me to pay another \$120 in addition to that. Unfortunately, I cannot afford to pay \$270 a month. I asked that the payments be spread out over 15 months.
