FORM F**UNIFORM MOTOR CARRIER BODILY INJURY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE LIABILITY INSURANCE
ENDORSEMENT**

It is agreed that:

1. Dear Sir:

Information before this Commission indicates that, on or about February 5, 1999, a certain motor vehicle, herein identified as a 1990 Kenworth truck, bearing Pennsylvania License No. ZP96620, Vehicle Identification No. 1XKBA58X0LJ542397, was checked by Barry Pacovsky, a duly authorized officer of this Commission, at Interstate 81, Dorrance Township, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania.

At that time, your vehicle was transporting mailing trays for compensation from Mountville, Lancaster County to Scranton, Lackawanna County.

Since you do not hold a certificate of public convenience issued by this Commission authorizing you to provide such service, you have violated the provisions of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §1101.

Continued operations, as described above, may subject you to penalties which may include the assessment of fines up to \$1000 per violation, as well as the suspension of your vehicle registration.

If you wish to transport property point to point in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it is necessary for you to obtain a certificate of public convenience from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. An application form with instructions and information on our safety fitness reviews have been enclosed for your use.
