RE: Stream Energy Pennsylvania, LLC's Request for Continuation of 5% Reduction in Security Requirements; Docket No. A-2010-2181867

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On July 6, 2016, Stream Energy Pennsylvania, LLC ("Stream Energy") filed a Letter Petition requesting approval to renew its security at the reduced level of 5%. In support of this request, Stream Energy submitted the requisite information for Commission Staff to process its continued security reduction approval including Stream Energy's gross receipts in Pennsylvania for the four most-recent quarters (from 2Q-2015 through 1Q-2016), Stream Energy's Tax Status Letter from the Department of Revenue, a check in the amount of \$350.00 for the required application fee and a verification attesting to the truthfulness of facts set forth in the request. Stream Energy continues to respectfully ask that the Commission approve this request.


In its initial request, however, Stream Energy also noted that its currently approved letter of credit will expire on January 15, 2017 but that date is not in sync with the Commission's prior approval of its reduced security level (September 4). In other words, the Commission's initial approval extends through September 4, 2016 despite the later expiration of Stream Energy's current letter of credit (January 15, 2017). To address this timing issue, Stream Energy's Letter Petition requested that the Commission extend the currently approved level through January 15, 2017 (rather than September 4, 2016) and then use January 15 as the annual date for approval of the funding level. Pursuant to further discussions with Commission Staff, Stream Energy is withdrawing this specific request to address the timing issue.

However, importantly, Stream Energy continues to respectfully request that the Commission issue a Secretarial Letter approving a continued security requirement of 5%.


