

With over 6 years experience in NY and getting close to 2 years of experience in NJ, AE understands all the financial risks in electric supply and has proven that it has the financial experience and money to continuously provide sustained and profitable growth in a fiscally sound manner. AE always been a profitable business and has been able to use its profits to not only pass on savings and value to its customer, but manage controlled, successful, sustainable growth for over 6 years. AE has grown from being in one state with 2 utilities and one Regional Transmission Organization ("RTO") to being in 2 states with 4 utilities and 2 RTOs. AE is very close to adding 2 more utilities within the next month. It has proven itself month after month, year after year to be well funded and stay fiscally sound while successfully continue to sustain controlled and profitable growth. AE's financials prove it to be well funded with a strong seven figure cash profit and credit over seven figures from various banking facilities as contained in more detail in the confidential filings. This is part of the reason that AE has so few complaints in New York even with 6 years of operation, as well as zero complaints in New Jersey coming up on almost 2 years of service. Since AE does not market to residential customer they refrain from the marketing methods that can be difficult and problematic to implement and police, and can result in complaints. AE prides itself on its outstanding customer service, it's attention to full regulatory compliance, and its low number of consumer complaints.

- b. **STANDARDS OF CONDUCT AND DISCLOSURE:** As a condition of receiving a license, Applicant agrees to conform to any Uniform Standards of Conduct and Disclosure as set forth by the Commission. Further, the Applicant agrees that it must comply with and ensure that its employees, agents, representatives, and independent contractors comply with the standards of conduct and disclosure set out in Commission regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 54.43, as well as any future amendments.

AGREED

- c. **REPORTING REQUIREMENTS:** Applicant agrees to provide the following information to the Commission or the Department of Revenue, as appropriate:

- **Retail Electricity Choice Activity Reports:** The regulations at 52 Pa. Code §§ 54.201--54.204 require that all active EGSs report sales activity information. An EGS will file an annual report reporting for customer groups defined by annual usage. Reports must be filed using the appropriate report form that may be obtained from the PUC's Secretary's Bureau or the forms officer, or may be down-loaded from the PUC's internet web site.
- **Reports of Gross Receipts:** Applicant shall report its Pennsylvania intrastate gross receipts to the Commission on a quarterly and year to date basis no later than 30 days following the end of the quarter.
- **The Treasurer or other appropriate officer of Applicant shall transmit to the Department of Revenue by March 15, an annual report, and under oath or affirmation, of the amount of gross receipts received by Applicant during the prior calendar year.**
- **Net Metering Reports:** Applicant shall be responsible to report any Net Metering per the Standards on http://www.puc.pa.gov/consumer_info/electricity/alternative_energy.aspx. Scroll down to the Net Metering Standards Section.
- **Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis per 52 Pa. Code § 54.39(d).**

- Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.

X AGREED

- d. **TRANSFER OF LICENSE:** The Applicant understands that if it plans to transfer its license to another entity, it is required to request authority from the Commission for permission prior to transferring the license. See 66 Pa. C.S. Section 2809(D). Transferee will be required to file the appropriate licensing application.

X AGREED

- e. **ANNUAL FEES:** The Public Utility Code authorizes the PUC to collect an annual fee of \$350 from suppliers, brokers, marketers, and aggregators selling electricity in the Commonwealth of PA, and an annual supplemental fee based on annual gross intrastate revenues, applicable to suppliers only.

- f. **FURTHER DEVELOPMENTS:** Applicant is under a continuing obligation to amend its application if substantial changes occur to the information upon which the Commission relied in approving the original filing. See 52 Pa. Code § 54.34.

- g. **FALSIFICATION:** The Applicant understands that the making of false statement(s) herein may be grounds for denying the Application or, if later discovered, for revoking any authority granted pursuant to the Application. - h. **NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE:** If your answer to any of these items changes during the pendency of your application or if the information relative to any item herein changes while you are operating within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, you are under a duty to so inform the Commission, within twenty (20) days, as to the specifics of any changes which have a significant impact on the conduct of business in Pennsylvania. See 52 Pa. Code § 54.34.

X AGREED

- i. **CEASING OF OPERATIONS:** Applicant is also required to officially notify the Commission if it plans to cease doing business in Pennsylvania, 90 days prior to ceasing operations.

- j. **Electronic Data Interchange:** The Applicant acknowledges the Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) requirements and the relevant contacts for each EDC, as listed at Appendix K.


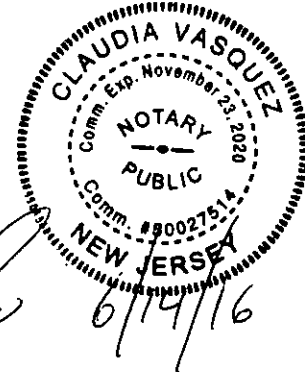



Generation Charge - Charge for production of electricity.

Transmission Charge - Charge for moving high voltage electricity from a generation facility to the distribution lines of an electric distribution company.

Non-basic Charges - *Define each non-basic service being offered.*

Terms of Service

1. (a) Basic Service Prices – Aggressive Energy, LLC (“AE”). *AE plans on offering both billing options and both fixed and variable rate contracts. All contracts and all of AE’s actions will be fully compliant with all laws, rules and Orders.*

FIXED PRICE:

Electronic Data Interchange and Internet Requirements

Prior to doing business in an EDC service territory, all Aggressive Energy, LLC suppliers, and any broker/marketers that wish to use the Electronic Data Interchange (EDI), must meet the EDI certification requirements of the EDC. Certification is a testing process using the Commission approved Internet protocol. To initiate this process, the EGS is encouraged to contact the EDC as early as possible after filing an application for a license with the Commission, since certification may require as many as four months to complete and customer service contract dates may not commence prior to certification. EDC requirements of new suppliers may be found on the respective EDC home web page. Pennsylvania's industry stakeholder group the Electronic Data Exchange Working Group (EDEWG) develops and maintains the EDI transactions and related business practices, which are found on the Pa. PUC website at http://www.puc.pa.gov/filing_resources/issues_laws_regulations/electronic_data_exchange.aspx. The EDEWG meets telephonically the first Thursday of each month at 2:00pm ET to discuss EDI change control requests and other issues.

If, for some reason, Aggressive Energy is unable to satisfy the consumer, the consumer can always contact the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PA-PUC") in a further effort to resolve the issue.

Additionally, Aggressive Energy has a regulatory specialist that then handles any and all regulatory issues from the PA-PUC or other entity. Dan Messina is the Vice President and Regulatory Manager for Aggressive Energy. Dan Messina also has the authority to use Compliance Specialist and Of Counsel Michael D'Angelo, Esq., as well as any other outside counsel experienced in energy compliance. Given the fact that Aggressive Energy will be servicing Commercial and Industrial customers there should be a minimum number of customer issues and even smaller number of compliance issues.

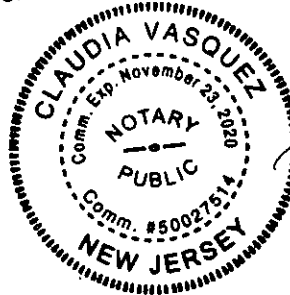
