Riggins, Jr. (Respondent) has paid, in full, his outstanding assessment balance for the July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016 Fiscal Year (2015-2016 Fiscal Year), as well as the agreed-upon civil penalty in order to resolve the above-docketed complaint without litigation. On July 12, 2016, the Commission received a money order in the amount of \$653, which constitutes payment of Respondent's outstanding assessment balance for the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year in the amount of \$133 and the agreed-upon monetary fine of \$520 for the failure to timely pay the Commission's assessment and file an assessment report demonstrating gross intrastate revenues earned during the 2014 calendar year.
