Maple City Transit, Inc. (Respondent) has paid, in full, its outstanding assessment balance for the July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016 Fiscal Year (2015-2016 Fiscal Year), as well as the agreed-upon civil penalty in order to resolve the above-docketed complaint without litigation. On or about June 3, 2016, the Commission received payment in the amount of \$373, which satisfied Respondent's outstanding assessment balance of \$366 for the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year. The remaining \$7 was applied towards the civil penalty in this matter. Additionally, on August 3, 2016, the Commission received payment in the amount of \$850 for the agreed-upon monetary fine totaling \$857 related to the failure to timely pay the Commission's assessment and file an assessment report demonstrating gross intrastate revenues earned during the 2014 calendar year.

Accordingly, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.24(a), I&E files this letter to certify that the above-docketed proceeding has been satisfied and should be marked closed.
