The limousine vehicles will be stored at the terminal located on 250 Bower Hill Road, Venetia, Peters Township, Washington County, Pennsylvania 15367. The terminal facility includes a 40 x 50 foot storage and service bay area, and an office area of 10 x 16 feet.

A Nextel radio system shall be included and installed in each limousine, with the base system located at the terminal. The terminal facility shall also have an office telephone and FAX system for customer calls and other business.

8. Equipment: Applicant proposes to buy 2 limousines upon approval of the application, as follows:

Two (2) 1999 Lincoln 10 passenger 102" stretch limousines.

9. Safety Program: All vehicles owned and operated by South Hills Carriages, Inc. will be kept and maintained in strict accordance with the PUC Safety Code, and all state,

federal and local laws, to insure vehicle safety and inspection.

4. General Description of Supporting Party: I would be seeking limousine service on behalf of my business, Campbell Insurance Associates, its employees, customers, and clients, as well as for personal and family use.

Availability of transportation at all levels is a long standing deficiency in Washington County. This problem has been repeatedly identified by county and local government officials. Many studies by public and private agencies have also documented this issue.

Both personally and professionally, I find that securing reasonably priced luxury limousine service on short notice is difficult. Services almost always require advance booking and calling multiple providers to make arrangements. This would indicate that the requirements for this service in Washington County are growing and that these needs are also increasingly more immediate and may not allow lengthy notice.

Most luxury limousine service providers are located outside of Washington County. My experience indicates that these providers are either operating at capacity or may be reluctant to service my market. 
