Dear Your Honor,

I am writing to state that I will not be attending the hearing scheduled for Monday, July 25, 2016 at 10:00am. After speaking with Patty Bernard from PGW yesterday, she stated that the only way to change this situation is to verify that I did not reside at my address 7259 Mansfield Ave. Phila., PA 19138 after August 2009 when the service was shut-off for non-payment. I moved out due to marital problems and went to live in my parent's home. Ironically, my home went into foreclosure in December 2009, and in order to save my home and apply for the various housing programs I had to maintain this as my home address. I continue to use this address because I am still fighting the foreclosure in court.

My husband and I were planning to divorce, which was delayed because of the situation with the house, but he has passed away on April 20, 2016, and needless to say when I received the enormous bill in February from PGW in my name he was not trying to be of any assistance (although he was responsible to pay this bill). When the gas was turned off, I thought he requested it to be turned off, and I was going to apply for it in my name. However, I will be going to court in October 2016 and I am hoping to finally figure out if I will be keeping my house or losing it. I have been living at 3718 Merrick Rd. Phila., PA 19129 and have used this address in regards to this matter so that I would not miss any written correspondence.

I am not withdrawing the complaint because anything has been resolved, I absolutely do not feel this is fair because I did not authorize the service in my name and I was not aware of the tampering situation. I am just unable to provide the type of evidence PGW states they require and Ms. Bernard also stated they never make arrangements on unauthorized usage anyway.
