To Whom It May Concern:

Your application has been reviewed and it has been determined that a certificate of public convenience shall issue upon compliance, Therefore,

**YOU ARE ADVISED to contact your insurance agent/broker so that the required evidence of permanent insurance will be filed with this Commission.**

**A certificate of public convenience will be issued UPON THE FILING OF PERMANENT PROOF OF INSURANCE and compliance with any other provision of this letter:**

- a. Form E, as evidence of bodily injury and property damage liability insurance.

**FAILURE TO FILE THE ABOVE REQUIRED EVIDENCE OF INSURANCE AND/OR COMPLY WITH ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS LETTER WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER CAN RESULT IN THE DISMISSAL OF THE APPLICATION AND REQUIRE THE FILING OF A NEW APPLICATION AND FILING FEE.**

You may want to operate prior to filing permanent proof of insurance. Temporary proof of insurance consists of two elements (Temporary proof of insurance is only good for 60 days from the date of this letter). Since you have filed acceptable temporary proof of cargo insurance, you need to file:

**For bodily injury and property damage (BIPD) only (submit one)**

- a. A copy of the insurance identification card for vehicles registered in Pennsylvania; or
- b. A copy of the declaration page of the insurance policy; or
- c. A copy of a valid binder of insurance; or
- d. A copy of valid application for insurance to the Pennsylvania Automobile Insurance Plan.


Upon the filing of acceptable temporary proof of insurance, you will be granted the right to operate as follows:

To transport, as a motor common carrier, property, excluding household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania.

Upon the filing of permanent proof of insurance, and upon compliance with any other provision of this letter, a certificate of public convenience will be issued authorizing the service cited above.

If you have not previously submitted a copy of current satisfactory safety rating from the U.S. Department of Transportation or another state with safety regulations comparable to Pennsylvania, you must demonstrate safety fitness by completing a Safety Fitness Review which will be scheduled by a PUC enforcement officer within 180 days of the date your certificate of public convenience is issued/entered. **Failure to submit to the Safety Fitness Review will result in dismissal of your application.**
