RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

The undersigned Grantor, BOROUGH OF MT. OLIVER, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant unto Duquesne Light Company, its successors and assigns, for providing, transmitting and/or distributing electric and/or communications services for any and all purposes, the right, privilege and authority to erect, install, use, own, operate, maintain, repair, renew and finally remove an electric line, consisting of one (1) pole (Item 2, #330654), together with crossarms, cables, wires, one (1) anchor at (Item 1 #27325) and other fixtures and apparatus thereto belonging, upon, over, under, along, across and through Grantors land, fronting on Transverse Avenue, situate in the Borough of Mount Oliver, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, (Lot/Block 33-M-140) and shown on Duquesne Light Company Drawing No. 611145, a copy of which has been given to Grantor. Duquesne Light Company shall also have the following rights: to trim or remove any trees or shrubbery which, at any time or times, may interfere or threaten to interfere with the erection, installation, use, operation, maintenance, repair, renewal or removal of the electric line; to enter upon the land at any time for such purposes; to permit others to attach crossarms, cables, wires and related apparatus, and to use the poles and apparatus erected hereunder; and to sell, assign, lease or otherwise transfer any or all of the rights hereunder.

Duquesne shall file a copy of this Agreement with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission as required by Title 66, Section 507 of the Public Utility Code and this Agreement shall become effective in accordance therewith.
