Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("Commission") Final Order entered on July 24, 2014 ("July 24 Order"), in Docket No. M-2013-2393141, Public Utility Commission Bonding/Security Requirements for Electric Generation Suppliers, Viridian Energy PA, LLC ("Viridian Energy") hereby respectfully requests that its bonding requirements be reduced from 10% to 5% of its most recent twelve months of revenue. As set forth in the July 24 Order, Viridian Energy has enclosed the following documents for filing with the Commission in support of this petition:

- (1) Attachment A, which is a gross receipts spreadsheet for the sale of electricity to retail customers in Pennsylvania showing each month's gross receipts for the most recent four quarters;
- (2) Attachment B, which are the a Tax Status Letters of Good Standing from the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue; and
- (3) Attachment C, which are the available Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards ("AEPS") compliance data from the most recent twelve months;

Also enclosed is a check in the amount of \$350 made payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to cover the requisite filing fee for this petition.





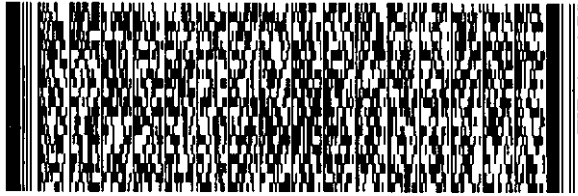

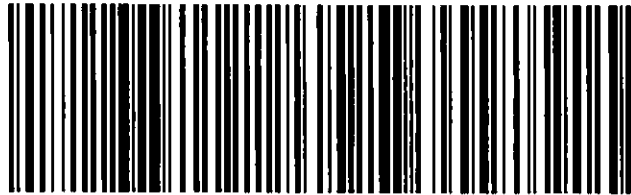
