- b. Form H, as evidence of cargo liability insurance; **or** cargo waiver.
- c. A certificate of incorporation is required for Pennsylvania Corporations. Please submit a copy of the date stamped certificate of incorporation as issued by the Pennsylvania Department of State.

*You are granted authority to operate as follows:*


*To transport, as a motor common carrier, property, excluding household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania.*

**FAILURE TO FILE THE ABOVE REQUIRED EVIDENCE OF INSURANCE WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER CAN RESULT IN THE DISMISSAL OF THE APPLICATION AND REQUIRE THE FILING OF A NEW APPLICATION AND FILING FEE.**

**You may operate pending the filing of permanent proof of insurance (Temporary proof of insurance is only good for 60 days from the date of this letter).**

*If you have not previously submitted a copy of a current satisfactory safety rating from the U.S. Department of Transportation or another state with safety regulations comparable to Pennsylvania, you must demonstrate safety fitness by completing a Safety Fitness Review which will be scheduled by a PUC enforcement officer within 180 days of the date your certificate of public convenience is issued/entered. **Failure to submit to the Safety Fitness Review will result in dismissal of your application.***
