Dear Sirs:

On December 16, 2002, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety instituted a complaint against D. A. Landis Trucking, Inc., respondent, alleging:

"That respondent, on August 17, 2002, at approximately 9:11 a.m., at Route 422, Wernersville, Berks County, Pennsylvania, permitted a certain 1996 Mack truck-trailer bearing Pennsylvania License No. AE79525, Vehicle Identification No. 1M1AD62Y3T1000358, to be operated. At that time, Enforcement Officer Donald L. Sheetz found said vehicle to be transporting lumber from Seven D Wholesale of PA, LP, Wernersville, Berks County Pennsylvania to DMI Home Supply, 2540 Haverford Road, Ardmore, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, for compensation.

Respondent was duly notified that, if an answer was not filed within twenty (20) days of receipt of the complaint, the penalty would be imposed.

The complaint and notice were served on respondent on December 17, 2002, and, more than thirty (30) days later, no response has been received from respondent.

Therefore, the allegations in the complaint are admitted and the complaint is sustained.

Respondent, within twenty (20) days from the date of the service of this letter, shall pay a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) by certified check or money order payable to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, at P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265, as provided in the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§3301 and 3315, shall cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§101, et seq., and the Regulations of this Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1, et seq.

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation is directed, pursuant to 75 Pa. Code §1175(a), to suspend the motor vehicle registration(s) of the vehicle(s) described above.
