
5. Approval of this application, is not necessary or proper for the service, accommodation, convenience or safety of the public.

O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission upon an application filed September 29, 1997. Public notice of the application was given in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of October 18, 1997. Protests were filed by Elite Industries, Inc., t/d/b/a Elite Limo; J & J Leasing & Rentals, Inc., t/d/b/a J & J Limousine Service; and Loma, Inc., t/d/b/a A.B.E. Limo & Bus Service, t/d/b/a AERO Chauffeured Limo & Mini Bus Svc.

The protest were withdrawn predicated upon our acceptance of a restrictive amendment which provides that no

transportation will be provided from points in the counties of Berks, Bucks, Carbon, Lehigh or Northampton.

The now unopposed application, as amended, is certified to the Commission for its decision without oral hearing. The record consists of verified statements entered on behalf of the applicant and nine supporting parties.

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS:

The applicant currently provides limousine service using stretch-type limousines, in all of Chester County, and from points in that county to other points in Pennsylvania, and return. The instant application seeks to expand service, to include points within thirty-five miles of the limits of Chester County. As a result of the restrictive amendment entered to secure the withdrawal of three protests, no service will originate within that thirty five mile area in the counties of Berks, Bucks, Carbon, Lehigh and Northampton.

Krapf's Coaches, Inc., is an established carrier with a fleet of 5 limousines and 4 executive vans with which to provide service. Krapf's is domiciled in West Chester, Chester County. As a currently certificated carrier, there is a presumption of fitness.

The nine supporting statements may be characterized as expressing the desire to have limousine service available for business and personal use ranging from once a month to as many as two times per week. The statements are representative of the expanded territory proposed as amended.

After complete review of the record;

We Find:

1. The applicant has the equipment, experience and fitness to provide the proposed service, as amended.
2. Approval of the now unopposed application, as amended, is necessary for the accommodation and convenience of the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the amended application be and is hereby approved so that the certificate issued January 29, 1993, shall be amended to include the following right:

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons, in limousine service, between points in the county of Chester, and within an airline distance of thirty-five (35) statute miles of the limits of said county, and from points

in said territory, to points in Pennsylvania, and return;

subject to the following condition:

That no right, power or privilege is granted to provide transportation from points in the counties of Berks, Bucks, Carbon, Lehigh or Northampton.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation granted in this order until the following is submitted to the Commission:

1. A tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the authority granted herein, to the extent that it duplicates authority now held by or subsequently granted to the carrier, shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event the applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of entry of the order, complied with the requirements herein before set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.
