Letter Petition For Reconsideration of 2/8/02 Decision

I am the Applicant in the above entitled application proceeding, and I hereby respectfully request reconsideration of your February 8, 2002 letter decision dismissing my above referred to application for non-compliance.

By order entered December 10, 2001, your Commission granted my unopposed application and established tariff and insurance compliance within sixty (60) days of December 10, 2001 or by February 8, 2002. Upon receipt of said Order, I immediately commence the process of compliance by contacting my insurance agent/broker and Kenneth D. Sataloff of the Tristate Household Goods Conference, Inc.

Attached hereto as Exhibit No. 1, find true copy of February 14, 2001 letter I received from Michael T. Kevane of Kevane Insurance, my insurance agent/broker, confirming that all insurance filings were made with your Commission on February 5, 2002. Also attached hereto as Exhibit No. 2, find true copy of January 11, 2002 transmittal letter to your Commission showing receipt of my tariff Freight PA P. UC. NO. 1 on January 14, 2002, together with true copy of said tariff with issue date of January 16, 2002 and effective date of January 17, 2002, all of which I received from the Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc. showing my participation in the referenced conference tariff filed with your commission. Also, attached hereto as Exhibit No. 3, find true copy of January 11, 2002 letter of Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc. to you Commission, acknowledged January 14, 2002, transmitting my Power of Attorney to the Tristate Household Goods Conference, Inc. to your Commission, together with true copy of said Power of Attorney.

On February 11, 2002, I spoke with a Robert of your Commission (at 717-783-5933) who informed me your Commission's records reflected all necessary insurance and tariff filings had been made with your Commission, but that the computer had already generated the February 8, 2002 letter decision dismissing my application for non-compliance, and he then suggested I file this petition for reconsideration.

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Therefore, in view of the foregoing and attached, the fact that this is a unopposed application for which compliance was timely made, and that I am a sole proprietor desiring to spend my limited resources on providing a lawful needed household goods service to the public rather than on the filing of another application (which I can ill afford), I respectfully request your Commission reconsider the February 8, 2002 decision of dismissal, reinstate my application and Order entered December 10, 2001, and issue a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to me.




