On behalf of our client, EDF Energy Services, LLC ("EDF"), Jones Day respectfully resubmits this Application for Approval to Offer, Render, Furnish or Supply Natural Gas Supply Services in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (the "Application"). On September 30, 2016, EDF submitted the Application to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC"). In a letter from the PUC, dated October 4, 2016, the PUC indicated that the Application was being "return[ed] as unfiled because we are only receiving applications with the dates of 8/1/16."

On October 11, 2016, we contacted the PUC Secretary's Bureau by telephone and spoke with Ms. Allyson Leonard regarding the PUC's October 4, 2016 letter and the return of EDF's Application. Ms. Leonard stated that the letter was sent in error, that EDF's Application should not have been returned, and that, in light of this situation, EDF may resubmit its original Application materials to the PUC for processing, including the original CD-ROM and postal money order that were included with the Application, without needing to re-serve affected Natural Gas Distribution Companies ("NGDCs") or provide a new certificate of service. ¹

EDF also advised during this call that it intended to revise Section 4.d of its Application. That section, which is entitled "Proposed Service Area" and is located at page 8 of the

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Ms. Leonard stated that the original Application should be resubmitted even though some of its pages bear the PUC's "Received September 30, 2016" stamp and markings where a member of the PUC staff crossed out those stamps prior to returning the Application.

Application, identifies the NGDCs in whose service territories the Applicant proposes to provide natural gas supply service. EDF had indicated in its original Application that it was proposing to provide service in the service territories of all eleven of the listed NGDCs. However, in the interim, EDF decided that it would seek a more limited authorization to provide service in the service territories of *three* NGDCs: (i) Peoples TWP LLC, (ii) The Peoples Natural Gas Company, and (iii) Peoples Natural Gas—Equitable Division. Ms. Leonard advised that EDF may revise its previously submitted Application by substituting a revised version of the affected page into the original Application and removing previously submitted material pertaining to the eight NGDCs that are no longer relevant – specifically, proof of publication of legal notices in newspapers located in those NGDCs' service territories. EDF has proceeded exactly as discussed with Ms. Leonard, as you will find reflected in the enclosed Application. EDF has made no other changes to the Application.

EDF respectfully requests that this Application be accepted for filing and that the PUC expedite its processing. To the extent that this submittal may be deemed not to conform with any PUC procedural or filing requirements, EDF respectfully requests waiver of such requirements.²

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
