Dear Mr. Longenecker:

By letter dated October 14, 2001, the application of Harry L. Longenecker, t/d/b/a Cove Trucking Company, A-00118124, was dismissed for failing to file acceptable evidence of bodily injury and property damage liability insurance and cargo insurance with the Commission.

This Commission has the power to rescind a Secretarial Letter in light of newly discovered evidence or a change in circumstances, which justify reconsideration. The record now indicates that evidence of insurance in the wrong name was on file with the Commission on the date of cancellation. The incorrect evidence of insurance should have been returned to the insurance company for revision.

We find that it is appropriate to rescind the dismissal of October 14, 2001. We are providing an additional thirty (30) days in which to have acceptable evidence of insurance filed. If acceptable evidence of insurance is not received on or before December 1, 2001, the application will be dismissed.
