
Dear Mr. Duncan:

By letter dated October 14, 2001, the application of Donna A. Leone, t/d/b/a Faith Courier, A-00118128, was dismissed for failing to file acceptable evidence of bodily injury and property damage liability insurance with the Commission.

This Commission has the power to rescind a Secretarial Letter in light of newly discovered evidence or a change in circumstances, which justify reconsideration.


