

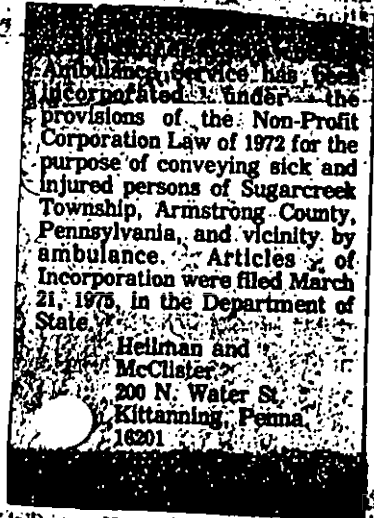

September 24, 1995

Purpose: Amendments of Articles of Incorporation

Robert Ramsey, Chairman of the Board called the meeting to order. Present were: Robert Ramsey, Robert Heck, James Baker, Judith Kaufman, Michael Steiner, Edward Fair and David Heck.

Robert Ramsey advised that a letter was received from Joseph Solosky, the company's CPA, in reference to our Articles of Incorporation. Amendment required to our current Articles concerning our not-for-profit status. Mr. Solosky mentioned that new language had to be added to our existing Articles of Incorporation in compliance with the Federal 501 (c) (3) section of the Internal Revenue Code.


Robert Ramsey read the new language to be added and a vote was taken to place these new amendments into affect. An unanimous decision of the Board of Officers to ratify this amendment.

The new language read:


Sugarcreek Township Ambulance Service is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and/or scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Sections 501 (c) (3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the organizations shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

Upon the dissolution of this organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
