On Monday, November 21, 2016, the Commission received a document faxed to the Office of Governor Tom Wolf, which was then forwarded to the office of Chairman Gladys Brown of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.


Since you currently have twenty (20) active formal complaints pending before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission against PPL Electric Utilities and Suez United Water, this document sent to the Commission from Governor Wolf's office constitutes an ex-parte communication prohibited under 66 Pa. C.S. Section 334(c).

As you were previously advised in the Commission's Secretarial Letter dated November 7, 2016, the two additional formal complaints you eFiled with the Commission on November 7, 2016, against PPL Electric Utilities and Suez United Water, cannot be accepted or processed since the issues you raise in those complaints are non-jurisdictional to the Commission. Any boundary or deed disputes, contracts, easements or utility rights of way, trespassing allegations, and award of damages that address the conditions of your property prior to and after its purchase may be sought in civil court. Furthermore, any filings you attempt to send through the Office of Governor Wolf are not acceptable under 52 Pa. Code Section 1.38.

Therefore, I am serving this Secretarial Letter upon the Office of Governor Wolf, and a copy upon the Parties of Record and Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey Watson in the above captioned complaint dockets to cure the ex-parte communication. Since the document you faxed to Governor Wolf, which was then forwarded to the Commission, is a duplicate of what you previously efiled and was rejected by the Commission for non-jurisdictional issues, it will not be placed upon the record or served upon the Parties of Record and Judge Watson.

Finally, you are advised not to send further ex-parte communications regarding your current litigation pending before the Commission.
