My office received your two efiled formal complaints today, one against Suez United Water of PA, and the second one against PPL Electric Utilities. Both formal complaints are being rejected for non-jurisdictional issues.

Please know that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission has no jurisdiction over contracts or other agreements regarding the purchase of your property, the current deed to your property, boundary disputes, or allegations of trespassing. Furthermore, the Commission has no authority to award damages or decide whether a utility should pay customers for loss or damages. All of these issues may be sought in an appropriate civil court.
