Dear Rosemary,

I am writing in regards to Docket No. 2016-2573562, and an official notice we received dated November 4, 2016 in reference to the complaint that was filed against RJM Trucking LLC. As I explained in our phone conversation on November 9th, this is the first year I am operating my business and I was unaware of the consequences of the course of action I took leading up to this notification.

I purchased my truck in September of 2015. I followed through with all of the necessary paperwork and responsibilities to incorporate the business, obtain my PUC numbers, register, and insure my 1999 Mack tri-axle dump truck that fall. I started operating in February of 2016. In August 2016, my truck ended up in the repair shop for over 6 weeks receiving a total inframe in addition to other repairs totaling over \$9000.00. I got the truck back in mid-September. At that point my registration of \$1561.00 was due by September 30th and my insurance was due to expire on October 5th. To renew that policy was more than an additional \$8000.00. Due to a multitude of reasons such as; not being able to work the truck, no income coming in, the amount of money that I would have needed to pay the additional bills, and the timing of the season for a dump truck, I thought it would be best to park the truck for the winter, drive for someone else, and resume running my truck next spring. I made this decision thinking it would buy me more time to come up with the money for the registration and insurance and I would just renew those prior to the spring working season. I was not aware however, that by making that decision it would affect my PUC numbers and jeopardize my business name.

In lieu of this, I was wondering if the \$500 penalty can be waived and if there is a possibility of having an extension to become compliant with you to keep my PUC numbers and business in good standing. After paying the extensive repair bill, I simply will not have the funds available for the insurance and registration until January 2017.

Please let me know if this is a possibility or if there is any other option available to correct this without jeopardizing my standing with you. Thank you for your understanding and consideration with this matter.

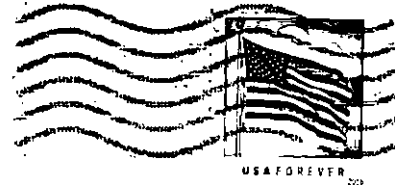
