
Dear Mr. Pillar:

The Commission is in receipt of the Objection on behalf of Diesel Transport, Inc., filed to the Commission's General Assessment Invoice for FY 2007-2008. In that Objection, you have stated that your client, Diesel Transport, Inc., has registered under the Unified Carrier Registration Program for the year 2007 and should not have been assessed pursuant to Section 510 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 510. After a review of your client's status as a UCR program participant, it is clear that you are UCR registered and, therefore, your client's assessment is reduced to zero.

If your client has already paid its assessment under Section 510 of the Public Utility Code, those amounts will be refunded to your client. The refund process takes approximately six weeks. If your client has not already paid that assessment, there is nothing due and owing to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission on this invoice.
