**MOTION OF PECO ENERGY COMPANY  
REQUESTING AN IN PERSON HEARING**

PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), hereby requests that the telephonic hearing scheduled on Friday, January 13, 2017, be converted to an In Person hearing and states the following:

1. A telephonic hearing is scheduled to take place Friday, January 13, 2017, before Administrative Law Judge Mary D. Long.
2. The Complainants allege in their formal complaint that they have experienced multiple power outages and power spikes, one of which caused a fire in their breaker box. The Complainants allege they suffered property damage as a result of the power spikes.
3. To defend against these allegations, PECO intends to present the testimony of several witnesses, including a voltage engineer, reliability engineer and claims manager.
4. PECO will also present exhibits with data in the form of voltage graphs that the witnesses will testify to.
5. Because of the technical nature of the testimony to be presented and the exhibits, PECO Energy requires the testimony to be presented in person.

6. Accordingly, PECO Energy requests that the telephonic hearing be converted to an In Person hearing because the hearing will involve multiple complex exhibits and witnesses.

7. The company will not be able to adequately present its case using the voltage data, graphs and records if the hearing is conducted telephonically.

8. Accordingly, PECO requests that the telephonic hearing be scheduled as an In Person hearing in the Philadelphia Administrative Law Judge offices.

9. PECO avers that the Complainants will not be substantially prejudiced if they are to appear in person in the Philadelphia office because their residence is only 45 minutes away from Philadelphia.

10. PECO has reached out to the Complainants via email and left a voicemail, requesting their position on PECO's request. The Complainants have not responded.

WHEREFORE, PECO requests that the telephonic hearing be converted to an in person hearing in the Philadelphia Administrative Law Judge offices.
