**MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

TO THE HONORABLE STEVEN K. HAAS:

AND NOW comes the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission), by and through its attorney, Bradley R. Gorter, and files this Motion for Continuance of the Initial Hearing in accordance with Section 1.15(b) of the Commission's regulations, 52 Pa. Code §1.15(b).

In support thereof, I&E states as follows:

1. The above-captioned Formal Complaint is scheduled for an Initial Hearing before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Steven K. Haas on December 20, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. in Scranton, Pennsylvania.
2. On December 15, 2016, the undersigned counsel was informed that I&E's witness, Robert Bingaman, would not be available to testify at the hearing due to a medical emergency.

3. Commission personnel who would have been alternate witnesses in this matter are also unavailable at the time of the scheduled hearing.
4. Due to Mr. Bingaman's medical emergency, and the unavailability of alternate witnesses, I&E cannot properly present its case before the assigned ALJ.
5. I&E requests a continuance in the matter scheduled at Docket No. C-2015-2507337.
6. This is the first continuance sought by I&E in this matter.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement respectfully requests that the hearing in this matter be continued due to a medical emergency, as set forth above.
