
On December 8, 2016 the Commission issued a Final Order on Reconsideration of PECO's Energy Company Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan for 2016-2018 at Docket No. M-2015-2507139. PECO was ordered to file a Revised Universal Services and Energy Conservation Plan within ten days consistent with the Order.

PECO is requesting a 30 day extension to file the revised plan. Due to the complexities of the change required by this Order, a detailed study needs to occur examining the potential impacts to our operations and billing system. PECO also wants the 30 day extension to determine if it believes a Petition for Reconsideration is warranted.


