NOTICE OF INTERVENTION OF THE BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION AND ENFORCEMENT

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.71-76, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) hereby gives Notice of Intervention in the above-captioned proceeding. In support thereof, I&E states as follows:

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC or Commission) with a mailing address of P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265, is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate pipeline operators pursuant to Section 501(a) of Act 127, 58 P.S. § 801.501(a).
- 2. Act 129 of 2008, 66 Pa.C.S. § 308.2, authorizes the Commission to establish bureaus, offices and positions to, *inter alia*, take appropriate enforcement

actions that are necessary to insure compliance with the Public Utility Code and Commission regulations and orders. 66 Pa.C.S. § 308.2(a)(11).

- 3. In accordance with Act 129, the Commission established I&E to serve as the prosecutory bureau for the purposes of representing the public interest in ratemaking and service matters, and enforcing compliance with the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. §§ 101 et seq., and Commission regulations, 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.1 et seq. See Implementation of Act 129 of 2008; Organization of Bureaus and Offices, Docket No. M-2008-2071852 (Order entered August 11, 2011).
- 4. Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 59.33(b), the Commission's Gas Safety Division, which is part of I&E, also has the authority to enforce Federal gas pipeline safety regulations set forth in 49 U.S.C.A. §§ 60101, et seq. and implemented in 49 C.F.R. Parts 191-193, 195 and 199, 49 C.F.R. §§ 191-193, 195 and 199.
- 5. I&E, through its prosecutors, has standing and authority to participate in all Commission proceedings and to initiate enforcement actions and prosecutions in the public interest. *Id.* at 5.

BACKGROUND:

- 7. On November 14, 2016, Laurel Pipe Line Company, L.P. (Laurel or Company) filed an application, pursuant to various provisions of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, requesting all necessary authority, approvals and Certificates of Public Convenience from the Commission to the extent required, authorizing Laurel to change the direction of its petroleum products transportation service over a portion of its system west of Eldorado, Pennsylvania.
- 8. In its Application, Laurel requests, inter alia, that the Commission either determine by final order that approval is not required for this change in service, or grant all necessary approvals and permit Laurel to change the direction of its petroleum products transportation service to delivery points west of Eldorado, Pennsylvania.

INTERVENTION:

9. As the bureau within the Commission that is responsible for ensuring compliance with the Public Utility Code and Commission regulations and orders, as well

as applicable Federal statutes and regulations, I&E is intervening in this proceeding to protect the public interest.
