On January 14, 1999 the Commission issued a permanent license at Docket No. A-110078, authorizing FirstEnergy Services Corp. the right to begin to offer, render, furnish or supply electric generation supplier services to the public within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.


On October 19, 1999, the Commission issued a license at Docket No. A-125020, authorizing FirstEnergy Services Corp. the right to begin to offer, render, furnish or supply natural gas supply services to the public, within the service territories of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc.; The Peoples Natural Gas Company; PG Energy, Inc.; Equitable Gas Company; National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation; UGI Utilities, Inc.; PECO Energy Company; Penn Fuel Gas Company; Carnegie Natural Gas Company; T.W. Phillips Gas & Oil Company; and NUJ Valley Cities Gas, within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

On October 2, 2001 FirstEnergy Services Corp. filed a request that the Commission authorize FirstEnergy Services Corp. to change its name on its license to provide electric generation supplier services and on its license to provide natural gas supply services to FirstEnergy Solutions Corp.

FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. has provided proper documentation as required by this Commission.

Therefore, the Commission approves, by this Secretarial Letter, the change of FirstEnergy Services Corp.'s name on its license for the provision of electric generation supplier services at Docket No. A-110078 and on its license for the provision of natural gas supply services at Docket No. A-125020 to FirstEnergy Solutions Corp.


