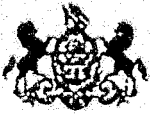

OPINION AND ORDER

On May 6, 1998, Frank J. Richards, P.E. d/b/a The Richards' Energy Group filed a License Application to operate as a broker/marketer of electric generation and related services. This filing was made pursuant to the provisions of Section 2809 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 2809. In its original application, The Richards' Energy Group requested a modification of the bonding requirements as required by item #20 of the license application consistent with Section 2809. On July 9, 1998, we issued an Order denying the application without prejudice. On July 23, 1998, The Richards' Energy Group filed a Letter Petition for Reconsideration. On October 19, 1998, we denied the Letter of Petition for Reconsideration. In response, on December 29, 1998, The Richards' Energy Group filed five \$50,000 bonds in support of its application as required by item #20 of the license application.

Frank J. Richards, P.E. d/b/a The Richards' Energy Group is an independent consultant providing energy and engineering services to industrial, commercial and institutional clients. The Richards' Energy Group developed an electric users group, called REAP (Richards' Energy Affinity Program), to present a diverse, high load factor load to suppliers to obtain favorable pricing and terms for the group.

The Richards' Energy Group has stated that upon the approval of this Application, it proposes to provide services to commercial and industrial and institutional customers in all counties within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The Richards' Energy Group has provided proofs of publication from the Pennsylvania newspapers in which it was required by the Commission to publish its notice of application.

Through responses to items 24 and 25 of its license application, which include its income statement and Dun and Bradstreet credit report, The Richards' Energy Group demonstrated its technical and financial fitness in order to be licensed to operate as an electric generation supplier in Pennsylvania.

The Richards' Energy Group has furnished five \$50,000 bonds, totaling \$250,000, as required by item #20 of the application.

As of January 4, 1999, no protests have been filed.

We find that the applicant:

1. Is fit, willing and able to properly perform the service proposed in conformance with applicable provisions of the Public Utility Code and the lawful Commission orders and regulations, specifically including 52 Pa. Code Chapter 56 (relating to Standards and Billing Practices for Residential Utility Service).
2. Has agreed to lawfully abide by all Commission regulations, procedures and orders, including Emergency Orders which may be issued verbally, or in writing during any emergency situations that may unexpectedly develop from time-to-time in the course of doing business in Pennsylvania.
3. That the proposed service to the extent authorized by the license, will be consistent with the public interest and the policy declared in the Electricity Generation Customer Choice and Competition Act.

Upon full consideration of all matters of record, we find that approval of this application is necessary and proper for the service, accommodation and convenience of the public,


**THEREFORE,**
