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INTERIM ORDER
SETTING RESOLUTION CONFERENCE

On or about February 22, 2006, Vincent J. Fabiani ("Complainant") filed a complaint against PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("Respondent"), at the above-captioned Docket Number. On or about March 20, 2006, Respondent filed an answer to the complaint.

Based upon a review of the information contained in this material, I direct the parties to attempt to resolve this matter themselves. Respondent shall contact Complainant no later than April 6, 2006, to set a mutually convenient time, date and place for Respondent and Complainant to hold a conference about resolving the case. The conference must take place no later than April 20, 2006, unless this is not possible.

Within ten (10) days following the conference, Respondent shall file a short report with Bruce Bigelow ("Mediator"), setting forth:

- (a) The time, date and place of the conference;
- (b) Who participated for each party;
- (c) A statement whether a full resolution, including withdrawal of complaint, was achieved, and, if not, whether the parties consent to have this case set for mediation by the mediation staff of the Commission; and
- (d) A statement of any issues which have been resolved, if a full resolution was not achieved.

The Commission encourages mediation if the parties cannot reach an agreement through the resolution conference. Mediation is an informal process in which the parties attempt to resolve the case with the help of a mediator. The mediator is a neutral staff member of the Commission who does not give advice, make a decision, or represent any party. Instead, the mediator assists the parties in their efforts to come to an agreement.

If the parties do not reach an agreement on their own, and do not consent to mediate, they are entitled to the hearing process. The hearing process usually includes the presentation of oral testimony and other evidence before a Commission administrative law judge, who will then consider the case and make a written decision to resolve it.


If it is not possible to have the conference by the date set for that purpose, Respondent shall file a report with the Mediator, on or before ten (10) days following the conference due date, giving the reason(s) why the due date could not be met.

In either situation, a report must be filed with the Mediator by the applicable due date set forth above.

1. Complainant is Vincent J. Fabiani.
2. Respondent is PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (hereafter referred to as "PPL").
3. This Certificate of Satisfaction of Complaint is submitted pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.24(b).

4. PPL hereby certifies that the parties to the above-referenced formal Complaint, now pending before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, have mutually and voluntarily agreed upon the following terms as full satisfaction of all outstanding legal and factual disputes in this proceeding, and Complainant has acknowledged satisfaction to PPL:

(a) PPL replaced the sections of cable which recently failed causing the outages to Complainant's property restoring electricity. PPL is scheduled to replace the entire section providing electricity to Complainant's property along with a third section of cable that was installed in 1983. Two additional sections of cable on the underground tap servicing Complainant's subdivision will be tested to determine the condition of the cable and then PPL will determine a course of action for

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those sections. The engineering to replace the sections of cable will begin in the near future and PPL anticipates construction will be complete in approximately four to six months. Should testing indicate additional sections of cable require replacement, the aforementioned time frame will most likely be extended to complete such additional replacements.


(c) Complainants agree to withdraw the Complaint with prejudice.


