INTERIM ORDER
DIRECTING AMENDMENT OF PLEADING

On August 27, 2004, Karen D. Mione (Complainant or Ms. Mione) filed a Formal Complaint with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) against PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (PPL or Respondent), alleging incorrect billing. On September 28, 2004, PPL filed an Answer.

I was assigned as the presiding officer in this proceeding. A telephonic hearing is currently scheduled for Tuesday, December 28, 2004, at 10 a.m.

Upon review of the pleadings filed in this matter, I discovered that Respondent had apparently placed the caption of this case on an Answer which was meant to be filed in a different case. The Answer which Respondent filed relates to a foreign wiring case, and not the allegations in this Complaint. Accordingly, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.93(a), I will direct Respondent to amend its Answer, to conform with 52 Pa. Code §5.61(b); therefore,

1. PPL shall file an amended Answer in this proceeding, within ten (10) days of the date of this Interim Order.

2. This Answer must conform to 52 Pa. Code §5.61(b), and therefore must admit or deny specifically all material allegations of the Complaint herein, and state concisely the facts and matters of law relied upon by PPL.
