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JUDGE FRED R. NENE:

Let me just set the scene. We are here today in response to a complaint by Eugene Schwartz against Peoples Natural Gas Company. The matter is Docketed at No.: C-20066068 and Mr. Schwartz is present telephonically. Peoples Natural Gas Company is present, represented by Attorney Horace Payne. My name is Fred Nene, the Administrative Law Judge assigned to develop a record and issue an initial decision in this matter. We are going to --- I have a court reporter here who is going to transcribe everything that occurs and the record will be available for review by the Commission. Before we start, I want to go off the record and have a discussion here.

OFF RECORD DISCUSSION

JUDGE NENE:

The parties have discussed this matter and the elements involved in the annual 1307F rate case proceedings and Peoples' witness has explained ---.

MR. SCHWARTZ:

If Peoples confirm that their calculation

7 JUDGE NENE:

8 All right.

9 MR. SCHWARTZ:

10 If it isn't, then I'll be happy to get an  
11 adjustment if that's the case.

12 JUDGE NENE:

13 Very good. And you're satisfied, then,  
14 that this complaint has been satisfied?

15 MR. SCHWARTZ:

16 Yes, I am so long as Peoples, you know,  
17 confirms that their figures are correct.

18 ATTORNEY PAYNE:

19 I'm going to let Ms. Urbaniak speak to  
20 that and ask her. Are your figures relative to the  
21 overall 1307F filing and what have you, and more  
22 particular to Mr. Schwartz's account, have you  
23 reviewed those and they're all in order?

24 MS. URBANIAK:

25 Yes, they're in order.

1                   JUDGE NENE:

2                   And you were prepared to testify to that  
3 at this time?

4                   MS. URBANIAK:

5                   Yes.

6                   JUDGE NENE:

7                   Okay. I'd ask Mr. Payne then if he would  
8 spiral a Certificate of Satisfaction with the  
9 Commission and we'll close this Docket.

10                  ATTORNEY PAYNE:

11                  Very well.

12                  MR. SCHWARTZ:

13                  Okay.

14                  JUDGE NENE:

15                  Okay. You're satisfied?

16                  MR. SCHWARTZ:

17                  I am satisfied, Your Honor.

18                  JUDGE NENE:

19                  Thank you, Mr. Schwartz. Thank you very  
20 much for, you know, being realistic about where we are  
21 here and ---.

22                  MR. SCHWARTZ:

23                  Okay. And I appreciate your help, Your  
24 Honor, and I appreciate the company coming forward and  
25 explaining.

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JUDGE NENE:

Okay. Then thank you very much, both of  
you.


