By letter dated December 14, 2005, complainant Marcia Lutter requested that the initial hearing scheduled for December 28, 2005 be continued and rescheduled. In this letter, she explained that the reason for the request is because she is unable to take time off from work at "his time of year." There was no indication that she had contacted counsel for PECO to see if this request would be opposed. I forwarded her letter to PECO, by letter dated December 14, 2005, PECO indicated that it did not oppose the request.

I am reluctant to grant this request, since Ms. Lutter gave no indication when she would be available to prosecute her Complaint. Since this is her first request, however, it will be granted. Ms. Lutter should be aware, however, that no further continuances will be granted except for extremely good cause. I strongly urge her to contact Ms. Lutz, PECO's counsel, to see if the Complaint can be resolved without the necessity of having a hearing.



Dear Mr. McNulty

This letter is to inform all concerned that I am unable to attend the upcoming hearing on February 28<sup>th</sup>. I have taken a new job which requires me not to miss any work in the first 3 months of employment. In addition, my take home pay is \$1500 less than what I had been earning. My PECO bill has been well above the anticipated budget of \$74 and I am struggling to pay the current bill (last bill \$164) on time without an additional \$96 being added on to that. In the past, PECO has added \$15 or \$20 additional to the current bill - not upwards towards \$100. I was forced to move out of my prior residence due to the discontinuation of child support and therefore having less income. I now find myself in a small apartment which is costing me the same to heat as my prior townhouse. In addition to all my other bills, as well as having had a recent serious medical condition diagnosed this past summer, and as a result of which I am still making up many past due bills, I cannot afford to pay PECO in excess of \$200 per month. A hearing is not going to change my financial situation. I have been paying my current bill on time. The past due amount has been on my account since my divorce back in 1989 when my ex-husband walked out on his family of 4, leaving me with a home with 2 mortgages, and all the other bills, as well as 3 babies. I have been doing what I can to pay off this bill. I am not in a position to pay a +\$200 per month electric bill and never have been (even though on many occasions it has been in excess of \$200 for the current bill)!
