
PREHEARING CONFERENCE ORDER

This letter is provided pursuant to our telephone conference held on Friday, January 5, 2007 in the above-referenced proceeding. As indicated in the telephone conference, UGI Utilities, Inc. ("UGI") and Farmer's Pride, Inc. ("Farmer's Pride") (collectively the "Parties") are currently attempting to settle the above-referenced proceeding. Both Parties have served initial Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents to the other Party. In addition, both Parties have served objections to certain discovery requests of the other Party. In light of the ongoing settlement efforts, the Parties have agreed to postpone the discovery process in hopes that the Parties will be able to amicably resolve this dispute.

In the January 5, 2007 telephone conference, Your Honor requested that UGI and Farmer's Pride submit a letter memorializing the details of the Parties' discovery agreement. Pursuant to Your Honor's request, the Parties' discovery agreement is as follows:

- UGI will submit responses to Farmer's Pride's Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents Set 1 on or before February 1, 2007, except for those Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents to which UGI has specifically objected, to the extent those responses do not conflict with UGI's general objections.



- Farmer's Pride will submit responses to UGI's Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents Set I on or before February 8, 2007, except for those Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents to which Farmer's Pride has specifically objected, to the extent those responses do not conflict with Farmer's Pride's general objections.
- Farmer's Pride's Motion to Compel responses to its Set I Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents will be due on February 8, 2007.
- The Parties agree not to propound any further discovery prior to February 12, 2007.
- UGI's Motion to Compel responses to its Set I Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents will be due on February 15, 2007.

The Parties are hopeful that they will be able to settle the above-referenced proceeding without the need for additional litigation. In the event the Parties are able to settle this proceeding, the Parties will promptly notify Your Honor. UGI has permission to state that counsel for Farmer's Pride has reviewed this letter and concurs with the statements made herein.
