(a) Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Bureau of Transportation and Safety (BTS) v. Suzanne Diehl Stewart, t/d/b/a Diehl Moving and Storage (Respondent)

(b) On August 27, 2001, the BTS instituted a Complaint alleging that the Respondent failed to maintain proper evidence of current insurance in violation of Section 512 of the Public Utility Code. The Complaint was served on the Respondent on August 27, 2001. No timely Answer was filed in response to the Complaint. By Secretarial Letter issued October 3, 2001, the allegations of the Complaint were deemed admitted, the Complaint was sustained, and the Respondent's authority was cancelled. The Respondent filed the instant Letter-Petition for Reinstatement (Letter-Petition) on October 31, 2001.

(c) The Office of Special Assistants recommends that the Commission adopt the proposed draft Opinion and Order, which grants the Respondent's Letter-Petition.
