1  
2 ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE ANGELA T. JONES: We  
3 are on the record. This is the time and place for the  
4 matter of Carolyn Thomas versus Philadelphia Gas Works  
5 Docket No. F-01802547. I am Administrative Law Judge Angela  
6 T. Jones appointed by the Commission to reside over this  
7 matter.

8 I note the appearance of Andrew Dasent  
9 representing Philadelphia Gas Works, also known as PGW.  
10 The complainant on most cases states as Carolyn A. Thomas;  
11 however, I do note that in the appeal from the informal  
12 decision as well as the decision by the Bureau of Consumer  
13 Services, she's noted as Carolyn Thomas-Smith. The  
14 complainat is not in the hearing room. I will note for the  
15 record that the address that we have is 8206 Ditman Street,  
16 first floor, Philadelphia, PA 19136. I will note that using  
17 the address we have sent a prehearing order as well as a  
18 notice of hearing for today's date at the of time 9:30, and  
19 those items have not been returned via mail.

20 Mr. Dasent, I will hear from you now.

21 MR. DASENT: Your Honor, I hope that you would  
22 entertain a motion to dismiss PGW having appeared today with  
23 myself AND Jennifer Raksnis who would be our witness and we  
24 have our exhibits and we are ready to proceed. In the  
25 absence we would ask for a motion to dismiss.

1 JUDGE JONES: Understood, Mr. Dasent, and I  
2 will rule on your motions in my written order. I do note  
3 that and let me for the record ask has the company been in  
4 contact with the complainant?

5 MR. DASENT: I haven't spoken to her.

6 JUDGE JONES: That is Ms. Raksnis?

7 MS. RAKSNIS: I haven't spoken to her during  
8 the course of this. I do believe I did attempt to back when  
9 I originally dealt with the matter and I never spoke to her.

10 JUDGE JONES: So we'll take the company's  
11 motions for lack of prosecution to dismiss under advisement  
12 and we will be ruling on that in a written order. Is there  
13 anything else that the company wishes for me to hear today?

14 MR. DASENT: Nothing further at this time.

15 JUDGE JONES: Very well, we are adjourned.

16 (Whereupon, at 9:40 a.m. the hearing was
