In early March, 2006, I sent to P.E.C.O. company a list of complaints about P.E.C.O.'s service to me. Since then I've spoken to them again about my payments that were missing. As a result of that conversation they sent me the Jan, 06 & Feb, 06 Duplicate bills I requested. However, when I called them back, I spoke to someone there named Patricia, about missing payments. On 3/16/06 I received 5 bills from P.E.C.O., 5 bills I've never received before to go along with the bills I did receive. I have not opened these bills. I believe these bills are generated to cause confusion & to harass me. Also, I found out that the energy charge P.E.C.O. is charging me, is for Commercial, & my account is suppose to be residential. RELIEF the high rate of .0608, .0685 for year 2005, & January thru March 2006, .0657 rate is too high for residential. Also, the bill for 3/13/06 - Due 4/3/06 - I can't pay \$404.72 - I will pay the \$560.11 + \$50.00 on the arrears if it is found that I owe any after this appeal section. I do believe that P.E.C.O. is cheating me and harassing me. What is happening with their Wind Mill system to generate better quality electric & cheaper production? Moreover, if P.E.C.O. has overcharged me via high rates, rates for duplexes & Commercial accounts, I want a refund with interest. Why do I have to pay a Customer Charge? P.E.C.O. should be grateful that I'm on board. Why is Distribution charges so high? No one is out here every year replacing & installing new lines. They should find some cheaper transmitters. P.E.C.O. has ruined the American Apple Pie dream. Shame on P.E.C.O. The Government does give P.E.C.O. Monetary aid, therefore I feel pinched by greed.

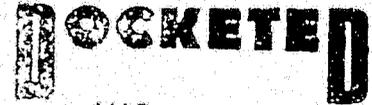

FORMAL COMPLAINT NOTICE TO RESPONDENT TO ANSWER OR SATISFY

TO: PECO ENERGY COMPANY

TAKE NOTICE:

That a complaint in the above entitled matter, of which the attached is a true and correct copy, has been presented and filed of record with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. Section 702 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 702, requires the Commission to serve on each party named in a complaint a copy of the complaint and notice calling upon each party to satisfy the complaint, or to answer the same in writing within a specified time; THEREFORE,

1. You have twenty (20) days from the date on which this complaint is served to either satisfy this complaint or to file with the **Secretary of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P. O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265**, an answer (original and three copies), in writing, under oath, which, as required by Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 5.61, either affirms or specifically denies the allegations in this complaint. You must also serve a copy of the answer upon the complainant. The date of service is the mailing date as indicated by the date at the top of this Notice. Section 1.56(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 1.56(a).

2. If you fail to either satisfy this complaint or to file answer or other responsive pleading within twenty (20) days, you will be deemed to have admitted all the allegations in this complaint in accordance with Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 5.61. In that event, the Commission may, without hearing, enter an order which either revokes or suspends any certificate or permit held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if

you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. The Commission is not limited to the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

3. If you elect to satisfy this complaint you must file, within twenty (20) days from the date on which this complaint is served, affidavits executed by each complainant that this complaint has been satisfied. Such affidavits must describe the basis on which this complaint was satisfied; any settlement agreement between the parties must be reduced to writing and attached to the affidavit. Such affidavits are to be filed with the Secretary of the Commission at the address set forth in paragraph 1. Upon receipt of affidavits of satisfaction from all complainants, this complaint may be dismissed by the Commission in accordance with Section 703(a) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 703(a), unless the Commission determines that such dismissal would be contrary to the public interest, in which event the Commission may direct that hearings be held upon the complaint.

4. If you file an answer which admits the allegations in this complaint, or which fails to specifically deny the allegations in this complaint, the Commission may, without hearing, enter an order which either revokes or suspends any certificate held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C. S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. The Commission is not limited to the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

5. If you file a timely answer which specifically denies the allegations in this complaint, or which raises material questions of law or fact, this matter shall be referred to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision. If, after hearing on the issues raised by that answer, you are found to have committed any of the violations alleged in the complaint, the Administrative Law Judge may render a decision which either revokes or suspends any certificate or permit held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C. S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. In the imposition of a penalty after a hearing the Administrative Law Judge is not bound by the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

the Complaint and states:

received a notice of service termination on or about June 15, 2005 due to the account delinquency; PECO Energy denies the notice was improper.

PECO Energy specifically denies that there are incorrect charges on Complainant's bill and further denies that Complainant's service is billed on a commercial rate. Complainant's service is billed on the residential electric service rate.

By way of further answer, PECO Energy avers that on March 9, 2006, Complainant contacted PECO Energy and requested duplicate bills for May, 2005; June, 2005; August, 2005; December, 2005 and January 2006. During that telephone conversation, four specific payments in May through October 11, 2005 were reviewed and confirmed. Duplicate bills were forwarded by PECO Energy to Complainant as she requested.

PECO Energy further denies that its electric rate increase is improper. By way of further answer, all of the PECO's rates have been approved by and are regulated by the Public Utility Commission and/or the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission. The charges are regulated by the Public Utility Commission ("PUC"); and they are contained within PECO Energy's Gas Service Tariff, Pa. P.U.C. No. 2, and PECO Energy's Electric Service Tariff, approved by and on file with the PUC. The Tariff provisions approved by the PUC are prima facie reasonable. 66 Pa. C.S.A. § 316 (1999); See also, Kossman v. Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, 694 A.2d 1147 (Pa. Cmwlth. 1997). Moreover, tariffs that have been approved by the PUC have the full force and effect of law and are binding on both the utility and its customers. Brockway Glass Co. v. Pennsylvania Utility Commission, 437 A.2d 1067 (Pa. Cmwlth. 1981).

PECO Energy also denies that Complainant is unable to pay her electric bill and strict proof thereof is demanded at time of hearing. PECO Energy avers that Complainant's account balance is \$2,072.67. Complainant's average monthly bill is \$179.00. Complainant's payment history includes many missed or partial payments.

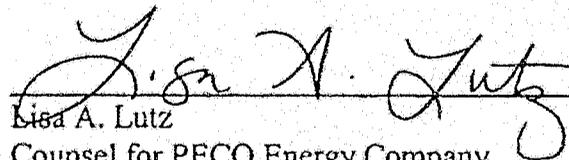
A decision of the Bureau of Consumer Services ("BCS") issued on or about February 14, 2006, set a payment agreement of a special monthly budget amount of \$304.00 beginning March, 2006. The BCS directed special budget amount of \$304.00 includes the regular budget amount of \$234.00 plus the monthly arrears payment of \$70.00. The Complainant has not complied with this decision. A copy of the BCS decision is attached as Exhibit A.

5. This paragraph is a request for relief and no answer is required.
6. PECO Energy is without sufficient information to confirm or deny this statement.

7. Admitted in part and denied in part. PECO Energy admits its representatives have discussed the Complainant's account with Complainant via telephone contact; PECO Energy denies its representatives were unprofessional.

WHEREFORE, PECO Energy Company respectfully requests that your Honorable Commission dismiss the instant Complaint.

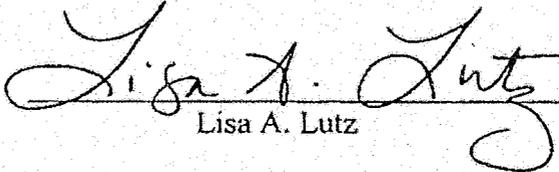

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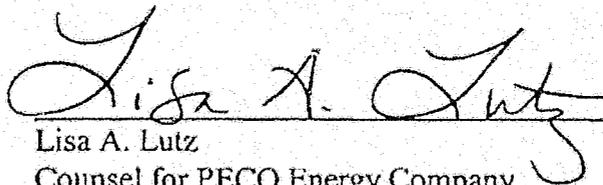
