4 THE COURT: Good morning. My name is
5 Charles Rainey, and I am the Administrative Law
6 Judge who's been assigned to this case.

7 And this is the case of Paul E. Stryker,
8 Jr., versus PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, at
9 Docket No. C-20067032.

10 I note the appearances by telephone of
11 Paul Stryker, who's appearing pro se, or in his
12 own behalf. And also the appearance of Kimberly
13 Krupka, Esquire, on behalf of PPL Electric
14 Utilities Corporation.

15 It is my understanding that the parties
16 have arrived at a settlement of this matter, and
17 desires of placing that settlement on the
18 record.

19 And at this time I'm going to ask you,
20 Ms. Krupka, to state the terms of the settlement
21 for the record.

22 MS. KRUPKA: (Unintelligible.)

23 THE COURT: Ms. Krupka, we missed the
24 beginning of that.

1 MS. KRUPKA: (Unintelligible.)

2 THE COURT: We're still having problems
3 hearing you, Ms. Krupka.

4 MS. KRUPKA: Can you hear me at this
5 time?

6 THE COURT: Yes, we can.

7 MS. KRUPKA: With regard to
8 Mr. Stryker's account, Number 5773840006, PPL had
9 billed him \$859.47, for a 154 day period.

10 PPL and Mr. Stryker have agreed to a
11 negotiated settlement, which would reduce the
12 re-billing by \$214.87, or 25 percent, which would
13 result in a total re-billing for that same period
14 of time of \$644.60.

15 In addition, PPL and Mr. Stryker have
16 agreed that PPL will provide Mr. Stryker to pay
17 that re-billing in a six month time period, of
18 six equal monthly payments, which will be paid in
19 addition to his current monthly bill.

20 So long as the payments are made timely,
21 PPL has agreed that it will not charge any late
22 payment fees, any interest, or otherwise any
23 penalties.

24 And that the monthly payments on the

1 re-billed amount can be made at the same time as
2 the regular billed payments are made.

3 THE COURT: Thank you, Ms. Krupka.

4 Mr. Stryker, did you hear the terms of
5 the settlement as stated by Ms. Krupka?

6 MR. STRYKER: Yes, I did.

7 THE COURT: And are you in agreement
8 with those terms?

9 MR. STRYKER: Yes.

10 THE COURT: Ms. Krupka, I'm going to ask
11 you to file a Certificate of Satisfaction within
12 five days from today, and, of course, provide
13 copies to Mr. Stryker and myself.

14 Mr. Stryker, with the filing of the
15 Certificate of Satisfaction, you will have ten
16 days in which to file any written objections to
17 that Certificate of Satisfaction. If you do not,
18 then the case will close.

19 Do you have any questions with regard to
20 that, Mr. Stryker?

21 MR. STRYKER: No, I do not.

22 THE COURT: Very good.

23 And, Ms. Krupka, is that something that
24 the company will be able to do, in terms of filing

1 that Certificate of Satisfaction within five days
2 from today?

3 MS. KRUPKA: We expect to do so today,
4 and I can (unintelligible) --

5 THE COURT: I'm sorry, we missed the
6 beginning of that, Ms. Krupka.

7 Could you start again.

8 MS. KRUPKA: Sure. We actually expect
9 to be mailing the Certificate of Satisfaction to
10 the Court today. And I can provide a copy to you
11 via fax, if that would be of assistance. And, of
12 course, mailed to Mr. Stryker at the same time.

13 THE COURT: Very good. And, of course,
14 also filing that with the Commission. Very good.

15 Is there anything else that we need to
16 take up here this morning, Ms. Krupka?

17 MS. KRUPKA: No.

18 THE COURT: Mr. Stryker.

19 MR. STRYKER: No.

20 THE COURT: I would like to thank both
21 parties for arriving at an amicable settlement of
22 this case.

23 And hearing nothing further, this
24 hearing is adjourned.
