**While you wait for us to reach a decision on your complaint, you must pay all undisputed bills (ones that are not a part of your complaint). As long as you pay all undisputed bills and return these formal complaint forms to us on time, the company is not permitted to terminate your service.**

**Commission Procedures for Formal Complaints**

- We send a copy of this letter to the company so they know you are appealing the Bureau of Consumer Services' decision;
- We also send the company a copy of your completed formal complaint forms. Once they receive it, they have 20 days to send us an answer to your complaint. The company will send you a copy of their answer.

- Once we receive all the paperwork, we usually will schedule your hearing before an Administrative Law Judge.
- We will notify both you and the company by mail when the hearing date is set.
- If you cannot travel to your hearing, you can request that the hearing be held by phone. This is called a telephonic hearing. If we can, we will schedule a telephonic hearing for you.
- We will most likely schedule your hearing sometime within three months after you file your complaint forms. If you know of certain dates when you will not be available for a hearing, let us know when you file your forms. We will try to work around your schedule.
- If you cannot attend the hearing on the scheduled date, you must request a different time or date. You should request the change at least 5 days before your hearing by writing to:





I have 3 children. One of which is attending college. I do not receive assistance of any kind. I do not qualify for CAP, LIHEAP, or LIURP. I've asked PECO what I could do to curb the cost + I don't qualify for weatherization. I weatherize where I live. I buy energy saving light bulbs + no one is home during the day so everything is turned off. I don't know how we can resolve this exorbitant bill.

My bill for electric usage @ my current address seems to be accurate + reasonable. I do not understand how my bill climbed so ridiculously high @ my former addresses. If there were a reasonable explanation why I was suddenly no longer on the CAP program + why my bills were outrageous in an apartment then maybe I could understand + agree to the original decision set forth by the PUC. But I can't. Especially given my <sup>current</sup> financial situation.



That a complaint in the above entitled matter, of which the attached is a true and correct copy, has been presented and filed of record with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. Section 702 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 702, requires the Commission to serve on each party named in a complaint a copy of the complaint and notice calling upon each party to satisfy the complaint, or to answer the same in writing within a specified time; THEREFORE,

1. You have twenty (20) days from the date on which this complaint is served to either satisfy this complaint or to file with the **Secretary of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P. O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265**, an answer (original and three copies), in writing, under oath, which, as required by Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 5.61, either affirms or specifically denies the allegations in this complaint. You must also serve a copy of the answer upon the complainant. 

3. 

4. Denied. PECO Energy denies that there are incorrect charges on Complainant's bill. PECO Energy also denies that her bills at prior addresses increased with no explanation. PECO Energy avers that it is currently investigating why Complainant is not currently enrolled in PECO Energy's Customer Assistance Program ("CAP").

By way of further answer, Complainant received service in her name at 1122 Hook Road, Sharon Hill, from August 31, 1999 to May 16, 2003. On October 17, 2001 PECO Energy performed a high bill field investigation at the property in response to complaints by Ms. Ortiz. No problems were found and it was determined that her bills were correctly rendered. The final bill from this address in the amount of \$3,625.10 was transferred to her subsequent address at 207 North Academy Avenue in Glenolden. Ms. Ortiz had service in her name at this address from May 13, 2003 to April 04, 2006. The final bill rendered from this address in the

amount of \$3,594.54 was transferred to her current account at 1401 Lincoln Avenue, Prospect Park on August 04, 2006.

Complainant was placed on CAP at 1122 Hook Road, Sharon Hill on August 08, 2000. PECO Energy is continuing to investigate the facts surrounding her CAP termination.


A decision of the Bureau of Consumer Services ("BCS") issued on or about September 08, 2006 set a payment agreement of a special monthly budget amount of \$290.00, beginning in October 2006. The BCS-directed monthly special budget amount of \$290.00 includes the regular monthly budget amount of \$126.00, plus the monthly arrears payment of \$164.00. 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


