

By Commission Order adopted March 22, 2001, entered March 23, 2001, which became effective upon its publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin May 5, 2001, the Commission adopted a Policy Statement which modifies the criteria to be used when considering applications for limousine authority.

The above referenced application for transfer of limousine authority is impacted by this change. As a result of the Policy Statement, all certificated limousine carriers are deemed to have statewide authority. Initial applications for limousine authority are considered as statewide requests. Applications to transfer limousine authority are no longer accepted.

In consideration of the foregoing, the application of Karen L. Peters, t/d/b/a Snow White Dove, at A-00117375, is being considered as an initial application for statewide limousine authority.

YOU ARE ADVISED: That the application for limousine authority be and is hereby approved granting the following right:


To transport, as a common carrier, persons in limousine service between points in Pennsylvania.

ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application filed May 1, 2000. Public notice of the application was given in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of May 13, 2000. The application was protested by the two (2) above-mentioned carriers. All protests were withdrawn upon restrictive amendment as discussed below.

The now unopposed application is certified to the Commission for its decision without oral hearing. The record consists of verified statements entered by the applicant and thirteen (13) parties.

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS

William Fedyski, president of System of Services, Inc., t/d/b/a Fantasy Limo Leasing (applicant or Fantasy), is authorized by the board of directors of applicant to present this statement. Applicant currently operates as a P.U.C. carrier providing call or demand, airport transfer, property and paratransit service. Its terminal facilities are located at 28 Georgetown Lane, Beaver, Beaver County. Applicant has in place a comprehensive maintenance and safety program.

The application is supported by thirteen (13) individuals residing at various points in the county of Beaver. Transportation is required between points in the county of Beaver and from points in Beaver County to Allegheny County, as well as other points in Pennsylvania.

The application was protested by two carriers. All protests were withdrawn upon a restrictive amendment providing that no service is to be rendered from the cities of Aliquippa and Ambridge and the township of Harmony, and to the facilities of Javy Enterprises, Inc. in the city of Ambridge, all in Beaver County.

After complete review of the record, we find:

1. Applicant seeks the additional right to provide limousine service.
2. The application was protested by two (2) carriers and all protests were withdrawn as discussed supra.
3. The application is supported by thirteen (13) parties.
4. Applicant currently provides service to the public as a call or demand, airport transfer, property and paratransit carrier.
5. Applicant has the equipment, ability and fitness necessary to render the service, as amended.
6. The evidence of record is sufficient to establish necessity for the service, as amended.
7. Approval of the application, as amended, is necessary for the accommodation and convenience of the public; **THEREFORE,**

IT IS ORDERED: That the application be and is hereby approved granting the following additional right:

To transport, as a common carrier, persons in limousine service, between points in the county of Beaver, and from points in said county, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa:

subject to the following conditions:

1. That no right, power or privilege is granted to provide service from the cities of Aliquippa and Ambridge and the township of Harmony, all located in Beaver County.
2. That no right, power or privilege is granted to provide service to the facilities of Javy Enterprises, Inc. in the city of Ambridge, Beaver County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation authorized by this order until the following is submitted to the Commission:


1. A tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission upon an application filed April 27, 1999. Public notice of the application was given in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of June 3, 1999. Protests filed by Kenneth C. Lapinski and Diane M. Lapinski, t/d/b/a Falcon Enterprises and Gold Cross Limousine of Pa., Inc., were withdrawn upon reconsideration.

The now unopposed application is certified to the Commission for its decision without oral hearing. The record consists of testimony given on behalf of the applicant and seven supporting parties at hearing before Administrative Law Judge Robert P. Meehan, October 5, 1999.

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS:

Margaret Mary Fielder, president and owner of Red Rose Limousine Service, Inc. (hereinafter Red Rose or applicant), testified on behalf of the applicant. Red Rose is a Pennsylvania Corporation domiciled at Transfer, Mercer County.

It holds interstate operating authority and provides service with one, 1999 Lincoln stretch limousine. The applicant offered a financial statement dated 10/4/99 as evidence of its financial capacity to provide service in Pennsylvania. The principals of the applicant report assets of \$391,500.00 with liabilities of \$94,800.00.

The seven supporting witnesses, three businesses and four individuals, all domiciled in Mercer County, testified as to a need for additional limousine service in the county of Mercer and from points in Mercer County to points in Pennsylvania, and return. The statements are representative of the county and service proposed by the applicant.

After complete review of the record, We Find:

1. The applicant stands ready, willing and able to provide the proposed service and has the necessary equipment, experience and financial capacity to begin Pennsylvania operations.
2. The applicant has support representative of the application area.
3. Approval of the unopposed application is necessary for the accommodation and convenience of the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the now unopposed application be and is hereby approved granting the following right:

To transport, as a common carrier, persons in limousine service, between points in the county of Mercer, and from points in the said county, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.
