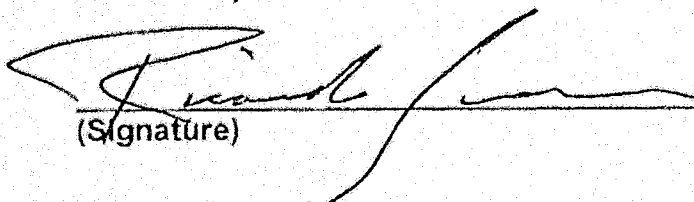

FORMAL COMPLAINT NOTICE TO RESPONDENT TO ANSWER OR SATISFY

TO: NATIONAL FUEL GAS DISTRIBUTION COMPANY

TAKE NOTICE:

That a complaint in the above entitled matter, of which the attached is a true and correct copy, has been presented and filed of record with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. Section 702 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 702, requires the Commission to serve on each party named in a complaint a copy of the complaint and notice calling upon each party to satisfy the complaint, or to answer the same in writing within a specified time; THEREFORE,

1. You have twenty (20) days from the date on which this complaint is served to either satisfy this complaint or to file with the **Secretary of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P. O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265**, an answer (original and three copies), in writing, under oath, which, as required by Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 5.61, either affirms or specifically denies the allegations in this complaint. You must also serve a copy of the answer upon the complainant. The date of service is the mailing date as indicated by the date at the top of this Notice. Section 1.56(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 1.56(a).

2. If you fail to either satisfy this complaint or to file answer or other responsive pleading within twenty (20) days, you will be deemed to have admitted all the allegations in this complaint in accordance with Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure, 52 Pa. Code Section 5.61. In that event, the Commission may, without hearing, enter an order which either revokes or suspends any certificate or permit held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if

you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. The Commission is not limited to the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

3. If you elect to satisfy this complaint you must file, within twenty (20) days from the date on which this complaint is served, affidavits executed by each complainant that this complaint has been satisfied. Such affidavits must describe the basis on which this complaint was satisfied; any settlement agreement between the parties must be reduced to writing and attached to the affidavit. Such affidavits are to be filed with the Secretary of the Commission at the address set forth in paragraph 1. Upon receipt of affidavits of satisfaction from all complainants, this complaint may be dismissed by the Commission in accordance with Section 703(a) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 703(a), unless the Commission determines that such dismissal would be contrary to the public interest, in which event the Commission may direct that hearings be held upon the complaint.

4. If you file an answer which admits the allegations in this complaint, or which fails to specifically deny the allegations in this complaint, the Commission may, without hearing, enter an order which either revokes or suspends any certificate held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C. S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. The Commission is not limited to the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

5. If you file a timely answer which specifically denies the allegations in this complaint, or which raises material questions of law or fact, this matter shall be referred to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision. If, after hearing on the issues raised by that answer, you are found to have committed any of the violations alleged in the complaint, the Administrative Law Judge may render a decision which either revokes or suspends any certificate or permit held by you or which imposes a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C. S. Section 101, et seq.; and, if you are a customer of a utility, an order may be entered which prescribes a payment schedule or which authorizes termination of utility services. In the imposition of a penalty after a hearing the Administrative Law Judge is not bound by the relief sought by the complainant in paragraph 4 of the attached complaint.

For its Answer to the Formal Complaint ("Complaint") filed against it by Ricardo D. Evans ("Complainant"), National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation ("Respondent") respectfully states as follows:

- 1) Paragraph one is admitted.
- 2) Paragraph two is denied. Correct name of Respondent is National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation.
- 3) Paragraph three is admitted in part and denied in part. It is admitted that Respondent provides natural gas utility services in Sharon, Pennsylvania. It is denied that Respondent provides steam heat utility services.
- 4) As to the allegations contained in paragraph four of the Complaint, Respondent states the following:

- a) Allegation: "I moved in a resident at 495 Nimick St., where at that time the gas service was off."

Response: This allegation is vague, as it does not state the date when Complainant moved into 495 Nimick Street. Respondent is, therefore, unable to properly formulate a response to the allegation and it is denied as stated.

- b) Allegation: "I at that time tried to get it on under my name. It was denied to be reconnected And I was given the bill from the current resident that lived there."

Response: It is admitted that service was initially denied to the Complainant due to a previous balance associated with the address and incurred by another individual who remained on the lease. Service was later provided and Complainant received a decision from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission stating that Complainant was responsible for the full balance. See Exhibits A & B.

- c) Allegation: "Which [sic] I never had service with this company before. I also never lived in PA before this date."

Response: It is denied that Complainant "never had service with [Respondent] before." To the contrary, Respondent's records indicate that a Ricardo D. Evans with a social security number identical to that of the Complainant maintained an account with Respondent from July 19, 2000 until March 6, 2001 at 407 North Street, Apartment C, Oil City, Pennsylvania. See Exhibits C & D. Based on this information it is also denied that Complainant "never lived in PA before this date."

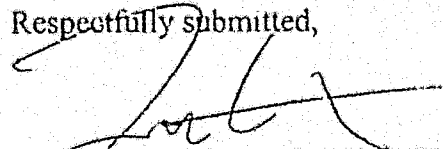
5) The allegations contained in paragraph five of the Complaint constitute a demand for relief and do not call for a response.

6) The information contained in Paragraph 6 regarding Protection from Abuse orders pertains to parties other than Respondent and therefore, no response from Respondent is required.

7) The information contained in Paragraph 7 regarding whether or not Complainant attempted to speak with a utility company representative about their complaint involves actions by a party other than Respondent and, therefore, no response from Respondent is required.

WHEREFORE, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation requests that the Complaint

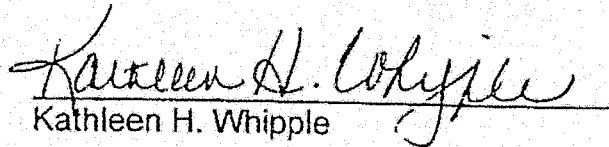

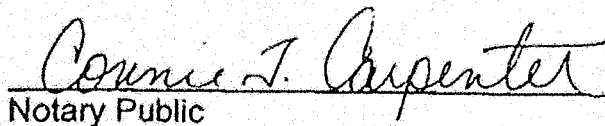

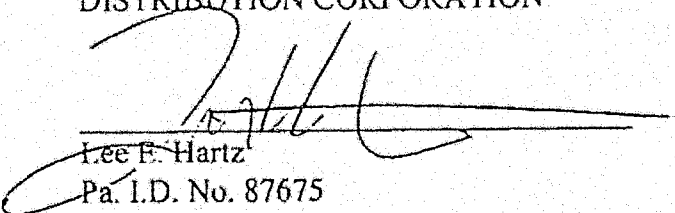
