
INTERIM PAYMENT ORDER

The Respondent utility has requested the Commission to issue an Interim Payment Order reminding the Complainant of his obligation to make regular monthly payments towards his Philadelphia Gas Works' bills while awaiting a hearing on the complaint, consistent with the Commission's Order in Charles Stammel v. PG Energy Co., A Division of Southern Union Company, Opinion and Order entered May 21, 2003 at Docket No. C-20027994.

In accordance with Stamme, the Complainant, Jemill Bantum, is hereby directed to pay his monthly Philadelphia Gas Works' bills, on or before the billing due date, unless otherwise directed by the Administrative Law Judge, until a final Commission Order is issued or until the proceeding is otherwise resolved.
